Standing to the W. E. at 2 PM raised a school of large whales lowered for them made a ball of wax at sun set hoisted the boats were ship and stood South handed light sails coiled down the try works at 11 raised whales again lowered and fastened to 1 of them and drewed the line from W.B. M. from

fine whale weather Lat by lrs 4.56 South

Long 103.30 West

Sunday
December 17th

Full saw a great number of whales in all directions lowered 4 boats and killed 1 of them and raised the Levi with the rest took our whale along side and shortened sail for the night hoisted on in the morning and began to cut at 9 finished and began to boil at 11 lowered 2 boats for whales
