employed

Saturday
the 9th of
June 1838 Westerly winds and clear
weather Course Wth Wth

Sunday
the 10th Wind from Sth to North
Course Wth Wth middle part
fresh gales and rain
double reefed the topsails
and hauled the main course
at 10 AM hauled the Fore &
mizen topsails 10 AM

Cruising in Chili:

Monday
June 11th
1838 At 4 hours P.M. the wind shifted
to the Wth Wth to the Sth
and set the Fore & Mizen topsails
Middle and Sutter part
light winds and clear
at meridian the wind at
Sth Wth Course Nth Sth Wth

Tuesday
June 12th
1838 Wind at Sth Wth and fine weather
steering from Nth Wth to North
shifted boats on the waste
cranes mended the main top
gallant sail &c
Lat by A.S. 31° 45'

Wednesday
June 13th
1838 Began with the wind at
west and pleasant at
4 in the evening the wind
shifted suddenly to South
and increased to 10 gale
double reefed the topsails
and hauled the Fore & Mizen
Course North by compass

Lat by A.S. 29° 51'
Long by D.R. 74° 00' W
