Tuesday June the 22d Day

First part fresh breezes from N.W. Course E.N.E. Saw fin backs
Middle & latter part fresh breezes from N.W. Course the same
Saw two sail standing to the Westward

Lat 40.44 North. Long 34.00

Wednesday June the 23d Day

First part light air from the Northward. Ship under all sail
standing to the Eastward. Middle part wind changed to
W. S. W. Course E.N.E. Latter part fresh breezes & cloudy weather

Lat 41.80 N. Long 32.34 West

Thursday June the 24th Day

First part fresh breezes from the N.W. Course E.N.E. Middle &
Latter part strong gales from N.W. took in top of sails &
main sail & close reefed the top sails. Saw a full rigged
brig standing to the Westward

Lat 43.04 N. Long 30.24 West

Friday June the 25th Day

First part strong gales from the Northward. Ship under
double reefed top sails. Course E.N.E. Middle part more
moderate. Latter part light air from W.N.W. & cloudy

Lat 44.17 North. Long none this day

Saturday June the 26th Day

First part light air from the Westward. Ship under all sail
course E.N.E. by compass. Middle part the same. Latter
part the wind changed to the Northward. with cloudy
weather & some fog. Ship under double reefed top sails
course the same

Lat 45.00 North

Sunday June the 27th Day

First part fresh breezes & cloudy weather from the Northward.
Ship under double reefed top sails. Course E.N.E. Middle part
strong gales with fog. Course W.E. Latter part fresh breezes &
clear weather. Course the same

Lat 46.47 North. Long 26.21 West

Monday June the 28th Day

First part fresh breezes from the Westward. Course E.N.E. at
sun down shortened sail. Middle part stood to the Northward
Latter part set whole top sails & kept off to the Eastward
Saw several sail going different directions. Also saw
black fish

Lat 47.32 North. Long 22.29

Tuesday

Thursday June the 29th Day

First part strong gales from the Westward. Ship heading
to the Northward. Close reefed the top sails & took in the
fore sail. At 4 P.M. took in fore top sail & wore ship to
the Southward. Middle & latter part more moderate. Wind
N.W. Ship heading W. by S. under short sail

Lat 47.09 North. Long 25.06 West

Wednesday

Friday June the 30th Day

First part strong gales from N.W. Ship under easy sail heading
to the Westward. Middle part the same. Latter part
more moderate. Made all sail & kept off N.W. Saw several
sail

Lat 46.55 North

Thursday July the 1st Day

First part gentle breezes & pleasant weather. Wind N.W. Course
N.W. Saw killis & landed three boats to no effect. Saw
a large ship standing to the Eastward. Middle & latter
part strong gales & thick fog. Wind S.W. Ship heading to
the Northward under short sail
