Friday July the 2d Day
First part fresh breezes from S.W. Ship heading to S.W. Saw
a large standing to the Eastward. Middle part wind changed
to the Southward. Ship under Short Sail heading to
the Westward. Latter part made all Sail & kept off
to the Northward. Ends with thick fog.

M. Observation

Saturday July the 3d Day
First part fresh breezes from the Southward with fog.
double reefed the top Sails at 1 P.M. & headed to the
Westward. at 5 P.M. were Ship & headed to the Eastward
Middle part strong gales from the Westward. Ship under
Short Sail heading to the Southward. Latter part much
the same with fog.

Lat 43.07. North Long 28.02 West

Sunday July the 4th
First part strong gales from the Westward. Ship under
close reefed top Sails heading to the Southward. with
frequent & heavy squalls. Saw a full rigged brig standing
to the Eastward. Middle & Latter part much the same weather
ends with strong gales.

Lat 47.20 North

Monday July the 5th Day.
First part strong gales from the Northward. Ship under close
reefed top Sails heading to Westward. Saw two barks. One standing
to the Eastward. the other to Westward. Middle part kept off to
the Southward. Latter part more moderate. Wind to the West
& cloudy weather. Ship heading to the Southward.

Lat 46.00. N. Long 28.30 West

Tuesday July the 6th Day
First part strong gales from the Westward. Ship heading to the Southward
under Short Sail. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate.
made all Sail heading the same. Spoke Bark Elias Richards of
New Bedford with 80 Bbls of sperm Oil

Wednesday July the 7th Day
First part light breezes from the Westward with fog. Ship heading to
the Northward in company with the Elias Richards. Middle & Latter
part strong breezes from the Westward with fog. Ship heading to the
Northward under double reefed top Sails. the Elias Richards in sight
to the Westward.

Lat 46.01 North. Long 28.12 West

Thursday July the 8th Day
First part strong breezes from the Westward. Ship heading to the N.W.
under double reefed top Sails. the Elias Richards in sight to the
Windward. Middle & Latter part wind the same with rain
ends with a calm.

Lat 48.45 N. Long 28.20 West

Friday July the 9th Day
First part gentle breezes & fine weather. Wind to the Southward. Ship
under all Sail heading to Westward. with some fog. Middle part
wind the same with rain. Latter part the wind changed to the Westward
with strong gales & fog. Ship heading to Northward under Short Sail

Lat 48.52 North. Long 27.28 West

Saturday July the 10th Day
First part fresh breezes from the Southward. Ship under all Sail heading
to Westward. Middle part the same. Latter part wind to Westward
with strong gales & foggy weather. Ship under Short Sail

Lat 49.28 North

Sunday July the 11th Day
First part fresh breezes from the Westward. Ship heading to the
Southward under double reefed top Sails. Saw a Sail standing
to the S.W. Middle part under Short Sail heading to the
Northward. Latter part made all Sail to the Eastward
fresh breezes & cloudy weather.

Lat 48.52 Long 26.20 West
