

Remarks On Board Bark Isabella While Cruising

Wednesday July the 21st Day

First part fresh breeze from the Westward. At 2 P.M. saw Sperm Whales. Landed & stuck one. Middle part took the whale along side. Latter part at day light hooked on to the whale & commenced cutting. No omb.

Lat 48.16 N. Long 26.00 West

Thursday July the 22d Day

First part fresh breeze. employed cutting the whale. At 8 P.M. finished cutting the whale. & all hands went below to get some sleep. Latter part at daylight called all hands & commenced boiling. Made Stew & Stew to the Northward

Lat 48.29 N. Long 27.00 West

Friday July the 23d Day

First part fresh breeze from the Westward. Ship by the wind on different tacks. employed boiling. Spoke the Bark Winslow of New Bedford with 70 Bbls of Sperm Oil. Middle & Latter part wind the same. with thick fog. employed boiling

Lat 48.30 N. Long 27.02 West

Saturday July the 24th

First part ship by the wind on different tacks. wind to the Westward. with fog. employed boiling. took in the Stewer boat & put out a new one. Middle & Latter part the same. employed boiling. with a thick fog. No Obs this day

Sunday July the 25th Day

First part wind to Westward with fog. employed boiling. Middle & Latter part wind to Westward with light breeze & a thick. Saw several Seal. finished boiling the whale which yielded 106 Bbls by the gauges of the Casks

To The North Of The Azores Or Western Islands July 1852

Monday July the 26th Day

First part light breeze from the Westward. with thick fog. Ship by the wind heading to the Northward. Middle part the same. Latter part much the same. employed breaking out the fore hold. ends with clear weather

Lat 48.39 North. Long 26.47 West

Tuesday July the 27th Day

First part light breeze from N.W. with thick fog. (Stowing) S.S.B under Short Sail. Middle part the same. Latter part wind to S.W. light breeze & pleasant weather. Commenced coopersing the Oil Saw the Ship Richards

Lat 48.31 North. Long 26.42 West

Wednesday July 28th Day

First part light breeze & pleasant weather from the Westward. Ship by the wind heading on different tacks. employed coopersing & Stowing down Oil. Middle part under Short Sail heading to the Northward. Latter part wind changed to the Eastward with much rain. kept off to the Westward. So ends this day

Lat 48.25 N. Long 26.40 West

Thursday July 29th Day

First part gentle breeze & pleasant weather from the Northward. Ship by the wind heading to the Westward under all Sail. Middle & Latter part wind & weather the same. Ship heading to the Eastward

Lat 48.27 N. Long 26.00 West

Friday July 30th Day

First part light breeze & pleasant from the Northward. Ship by the wind heading to the Eastward under all Sail. The Ship Richards in sight. Middle part thick & rainy. Ship heading to the Eastward. Latter part heading by the wind to the Westward thick fog. So ends this day
