Saturday August 21st Day
First part fresh trade ship under all sail. Course S.S.W. the
Sappho in company. Middle & last part much the same
Course S.S.W. by compass. As ends
Lat 23.45 North Long 23.24 West

Sunday August 22d Day
First part fresh trade. Course S.S.W. the Sappho in company
Middle & last part the same. Ship under all sail
Lat 21.40 N. Long 24.23 West

Monday August 23d Day
First part light trade. Course S.S.W. the Sappho in company
this day. At 6 1/2 PM died on board a seaman by the name
of Friday he called on board ship a native of Easter Island
after a short illness. Disease inflammation on the bowels.
Middle & last part wind & course the same. At 7 AM
buried the above named man

Tuesday August 24th Day
First part fresh trade wind. Course S.W. by compass. the
Sappho in company. Saw three sail standing different
directions. Middle & last part wind & course the same as
above
At 6 PM

Wednesday August 25th Day
First part fresh trade. Course S.S.W. by compass. the Sappho
in company. Saw the Antonia at 1 1/2 PM bearing bearing
S.E. by compass distant by estimation 15 miles. Middle part light
air & calm. Course S.S.E. Latter part buffing winds & calm
Course the same. ends with cloudy weather
At 6 PM this day,

Off Cape Verde Islands August 1852

Thursday August 26th Day
First part light air from N.E. & cloudy weather. Course S.S.E. Middle
& latter part light air from the Southward. Ship heading by the
wind on different tacks. the Sappho in company. At 7 AM Barrow
in sight bearing S.S.W. also the Island of Congo bearing South
At 6 PM

Friday August 27th Day
First part light breeze from the Southward. Ship heading by the wind
on different tacks working up for the land. Middle & last part
light buffing winds & calm. Ship under all sail. the Sappho
in company.

Saturday August 28th Day
First part calm & buffing winds from all points of the compass
Ship working up for the land. Middle part took a fresh breeze
from N.E. & stood in to the land. At 7 AM the boat went
ashore

Sunday August 29th Day
First part light breeze from the Eastward. Ship lying off & on
at Barrow at 6 PM the boat came on board & brought off
three men. also some pigs. Middle part blowing S.S.W. by
compass. the Sappho in company. wind N. Latter part squally
& raining from the Eastward.
At 6 PM

Monday August 30th Day
First part light breeze from the Eastward. Squally & raining. Ship
heading to the Southward. Spoke the Bark Active. the
Sappho in sight. Middle & latter part buffing winds &
calm. Ship heading to the Southward under all sail
two sail in sight.
