Tuesday Aug 31st Day
First part light airs from S.E. Ship under all sail heading
the Sappho Active & two other sails in sight
Middle & last part light airs from N. to N.E. Ship under
all sail came south by compass. Several sail in
sight
Lat 12.11. N. Long 24.34 West

Wednesday Aug Sept 1st Day
First part light breeze from N. to N.E. Ship under all sail
Came S.E. Several sail in sight. Middle & last part
calm. Saw black fish several & caught two of them
Lat 11.17 N. Long 24.56 West

Thursday Sept 2^d Day
First part light airs from S.E. Ship under all sail
heading Southwesterly three sail in sight. Middle
& last part light airs from the Southward. Ship heading
by the wind on different tacks
Lat 11.01 North. Long 25.01 West

Friday Sept the 3^d Day
First part light breeze from the Southward. Ship on
different tacks. Spoke bark Finny, Master of Liverpool
bound to Falmouth, England. Saw several other ships
Middle part baffling winds squally & rain. Latter part
light airs from the Northward. Steaming to the Northward
Commenced boiling the black fish blubber
Lat 10.11 N. Long 24.18 West

Saturday Sept the 4th Day
First part light breeze from the Northward, steaming to the
Southward. Several sail in sight. finished boiling the black
fish blubber. Middle part baffling winds & calm. Course S.
by compass. Latter part light airs from the Northward. Course
the same
Lat 9.21 North. Long 24.11 West

Cape Verde Bound To The Southward 1852

Sunday Sept the 5th Day
First part squally & rainy from the eastward. Course south
by compass. Several sail in sight. Middle part wind changeable
Ship heading on different tacks. Latter part fresh breeze from S.W.
Ship heading S.E. by S. under all sail
Lat 8.29 N. Long 22.53 West

Monday Sept the 6th Day
First part fresh breeze from S.W. Ship heading S.E. by S. under all
sail. Several sail in sight. Middle & last part wind west
Ship heading S.W. Spoke the Fanny Perry two months from
New Bedford clean
Lat 7.30 N. Long 21.40 West

Tuesday Sept the 7th Day
First part light breeze from the westward. Ship heading
S.E. by W. by compass two sail in sight. Middle & last part fresh
breeze from N. to S.W. Ship heading from S.S.W. to S.S.E.

Wednesday Sept the 8th Day
First part fresh gale from S.W. Ship heading S.S.E. Several sail
in sight Middle part the same. Latter part backed ship
& stood to the westward wind S.S.W. Ship heading W. by compass
Lat 4.42 North Long 18.43 West

Thursday Sept the 9th Day
First part squally & rainy, fresh breeze from S.W. Ship heading
West by compass. Saw a number of ships. At 5 P.M. saw
a school of sperm whales going N.E. to late to leave for
them it coming on dark before we could get up to them.
Middle & last part light airs from the Southward. Ship
by the wind heading W.S.W.
