Friday Sept the 10th Day
First part pleasant weather & light breeze from south. Ship heading W.S.W. with all sail set. Middle part the wind changed to S.W. tacked ship & stood to the S.E. latter part tacked again to the Westward.
Lat 3.58 North. Long 21.14 west

Saturday Sept the 11th Day
First part fresh breeze from S.W. Ship under all sail heading to the Westward. At dark tacked ship to the Eastward. Middle & last part heading from W to W.S.W. Strong breeze from the Southward.
Lat 3.32 N. Long 22.50 west

Sunday Sept the 12th Day
First part fresh breeze from the Southward. Ship heading from W by S to W.S.W. by compass. Middle part the same. Latter part heading S.W. by W. Saw a bird standing to the Southward.
Lat 2.32 N. Long 24.39 west

Monday Sept the 13th Day
First part fresh breeze from S.S.E. Ship heading S.W. by W. Middle & last part ship heading from W.S.W. to W with fresh breeze. One bird in sight.
Lat 0.35 North. Long 26.28 west

Tuesday Sept the 14th Day
First part fresh breeze from S.S.E. Ship under all sail heading S.W. by compass. One bird in sight. Middle & last part much the same. Ship heading from S.W. to S.W. by S. This day crossed the equatorial line.
Lat 1.43 South. Long 28.09 west

Wednesday Sept the 15th Day
First part fresh breeze from S.S.E. Ship heading S.W. by S by compass. Middle & last part much the same. No birds this day.
Lat 3.55 S. Long 29.21 west

Thursday Sept the 16th Day
First part fresh breeze from S.S.E. Ship heading S.W. by S by the wind. Middle & last part much the same. Ship heading from S.W. to S.S.W.
Lat 5.35 S. Long 30.38 west

Friday Sept the 17th Day
First part fresh breeze from S.S.E. Ship by the wind heading from S.W. to S.S.W. Middle & last part much the same as first. With a large swell from the Southward. Saw a bird standing to the Southward.
Lat 7.17 S. Long 31.48 west

Saturday Sept the 18th Day
First part fresh trade winds. Ship by the wind heading S.S.W. by compass. Middle part strong trade. Tack in the top galant sail. heading from S to S.S.W. Latter part strong trade. Single reefed the top sails.
Lat 9.11 S. Long 32.29 west

Sunday Sept the 19th Day
First part fresh trade. Ship heading S.S.W. under single reefed top sail. With top galant sail set over them. Middle & last part fresh trade. Ship heading from S.W. to S.S.W. Saw a bird standing to the Southward.
Lat 11.05 South. Long 33.13 west

Monday Sept the 20th Day
First part fresh trade. heading by the wind from S.W. to S.S.W. Saw a bird standing to the Southward. Middle & last part much the same.
Lat 13.22 South. Long 33.54 west

Tuesday Sept the 21st Day
First part light breeze & pleasant weather. At 1 P.M. Saw two sperm whales. Landed all four of the boats without success. Middle & last part strong trade. Ship heading Southward.
Lat 14.47 South. Long 34.57 west
