

Remarks On Board Bark Isabella Toward River Lea

Monday Oct the 11th Day

First part light breeze from the S.E. Ship under all sail heading S.S.W. Middle part much the same. Latter part strong gale from south. Close reefed the top sails. Ship heading S.W. Lat 30.58 South. Long 44.26 West

Tuesday Oct the 12th Day

First part strong gale from the Southward. Ship under close reefed top sails heading to the S.W. Middle part more moderate. Latter part light breeze & cloudy weather. Made all sail heading S.S.W.

Lat 31.25 S. Long 45.05 West

Wednesday Oct the 13th Day

First part light air from S.E. & cloudy weather. Ship under all sail heading S.S.W. by the wind. Middle part the wind changed to the Eastward. Ship heading the same. Latter part light air & pleasant weather. Course S.W. Wind East

Lat 32.14 S. Long 46.02 West

Thursday Oct the 14th Day

First part light breeze & pleasant from the Eastward. Course S.W. by compass. Saw a Sail Manoeuvring to the Southward. Middle & last part wind & weather much the same as the first part. Saw several fin backs.

Lat 32.55 South. Long 47.28 West

Friday Oct the 15th Day

First part gentle breeze & fine pleasant weather. Wind N.E. Course S.W. one sail in sight & many fin backs whals. At Sun down shortened sail. Middle part heading by the wind to the Eastward. Latter part much all sail at day light to the S.W. Wind N.E.

Lat 33.52 South. Long 47.48 West

Plate And Fulkland Islands October 1852

Saturday Oct the 16th Day

First part fresh gale from S.E. Course S.W. by S. by compass. Middle part fresh gale from S. Course S.W. Latter part much the same course south by compass Lat 33.25 South

Sunday Oct the 17th Day

First part strong gale from the Northward. Course S. by compass. Middle part more moderate. Latter part fresh gale from S.E. Ship heading to the Southward under all sail. ends with thick fog. W.B. C.

Monday Oct the 18th Day

First part strong gale with much rain from the Eastward took in all sail except a close reefed main top sail. Middle part strong gale. at midnight the wind changed to the Southward. Latter part more moderate. Made some sail & wore ship to the Eastward

Lat 37.26 S. Long 49.14 West

Tuesday Oct the 19th Day

First part strong gale & clear weather from the Southward. Ship under a close reefed main top sail heading to the Eastward. Middle part more moderate. Latter part light breeze from the Southward with a large swell. Made sail to the S.E.

Lat 37.39 South Long 48.38 West

Wednesday Oct the 20th Day

First part light air from the Eastward. Ship heading to the Northward under all sail. Middle part wind changed to N.E. Course S. by W. Latter part fresh gale & cloudy weather Course South. Ship under all sail. W.B. C.
