Thursday Oct. the 21st Day

First part cloudy weather & fresh gales from the northward steering South by Compass. Middle & last part much the same as the first. With some rain & also some fog ends clear

Lat 40.57 South. Long 49.48 West

Friday Oct. the 22^d Day

First part fresh breezes from the Northward with fog & rain Course S.W. by S. Middle part the wind changed to the Southward Latter part calm. One sail in sight

Lat 41.14 South. Long 50.02 West

Saturday Oct. the 23^d Day

First part light breezes & pleasant from the Westward. Spoke Ship John of New Bedford 5 months out with 70 Bbls of oil Middle & last part fresh gales. Ship heading to the Northward under all sail

Lat 41.45 S. Long 50.32 West

Sunday Oct. the 24th Day

First part light breezes from the Westward & pleasant weather. Ship under all sail heading to the Southward. Middle & last part strong gales from N.W. close reefed the top sails. Ship heading to the Southward

Lat 42.21 S. Long 51.12 West

Monday Oct. the 25th Day

First part strong gales from N.W. to S.W. Ship under short sail heading to the S.E. Middle part more moderate made some sail. Latter part at day light made all sail. The wind changed to the N.W. & commenced to blow again ends with strong gales. This day released Cooper from his lions & put him to his duty, he having been confined since the second of this month.

Toward The Falkland Islands October 1852

Tuesday Oct. the 26th Day

First part strong gales from N.W. Ship under short sail heading by the wind to the N.E. Middle part more moderate. Ship heading to the Southward. Latter part fine weather & light breezes from N.W. Course S.W. by S.

Lat 42.26 South. Long 50.54 West

Wednesday Oct. the 27th Day

First part fresh breezes from N.W. Ship under all sail. Course S.W. Middle & last part much the same as first part Course S.W. by South

Lat 44.28 South. Long 52.46 West

Thursday Oct. the 28th Day

First part strong gales from N.W. Ship under double reefed top sails. Course S.W. by Compass. Middle part more moderate. Latter part calm. Saw fin backs. lowered two boats & chased them to no effect.

Lat 45.33 S. Long 53.32 West

Friday Oct. the 29th Day

First part gentle breezes & fine weather from the Eastward Course N.W. by S. by Compass. Middle part fresh breezes from N.W. with thick fog. Latter part strong gales from N.W. with some fog. Ship under short sail heading to the Southward

Lat 46.19 South. Long 56.14 West

Saturday Oct. the 30th Day

First part strong gales from the Westward. Ship under short sail heading to the Southward. Middle part the wind changed to the Southward & moderated. Ship under short sail heading to the Westward. Latter part fine weather made all sail & stood to the Westward. One sail in sight
