

Remarks On Board Bark Isabella While Cruising

To The Northward Of The Falkland Islands Novem 1832

Sunday Oct the 31st Day
First part light air from the westward & pleasant weather. Ship under all sail heading to the Southward. One sail in sight. Middle part calm. Latter part light air from the eastward & fine weather. Course S.W.

Lat 46.27 South Long 56.47 West

Monday November the 1st Day
First part light air from N.E. Steaming S.W. by compass under all sail. Middle part under short sail heading by the wind to the Westward. Latter part made all sail & stood to the Westward. ends with fresh gales from the westward.

Lat 46.37 South

Tuesday November the 2nd Day
First part fresh gales from the Northward. Ship under whole top sails Steaming different courses. At sun down took in sail for the night. Middle part heading to the N.E. under short sail. Latter part light air & foggy weather.

Wednesday November the 3rd
First part light air from the Southward & calm. Steaming different courses. One sail in sight. Middle & last part light air & a thick fog. Ship heading on different tracks under short sail. Wind to eastward.

Thursday November the 4th Day
First part foggy, wind N.E. Ship under short sail. Spoke the Sappho of New Bedford. No Oil on board. Middle part strong gales from the Northward with fog. Ship under short sail heading to eastward. Latter part foggy. Ship heading to the westward.

Friday November the 5th Day
First part strong gales with fog from the Northward. Ship under short sail heading to westward. Saw the Sappho. Middle & last part much the same as first part. ends with thick fog.

W B Chs

Saturday November the 6th Day
First part strong gales from the Northward. Ship under double reefed top sails. The Sappho in sight. Saw a large ship standing to Southward. Took in sail for the night at sun down. Middle part more moderate. Latter part light breezes & cloudy. Wind to Westward. Made all sail to the Northward.

Lat 46.37 South. Long 57.23 West

Sunday November the 7th
First part light breezes & cloudy weather. Wind S.E. Ship heading to the N.E. at sun down took in sail for the night. Middle & last part calm. Two sail in sight.

Lat 46.38 South Long 57.14

Monday November the 8th
First part light air from N. to N.E. & pleasant weather. Two sail in sight. At sun down took in sail for the night. Middle part wind from N.N.W. Ship under short sail heading on different tracks. Latter part fresh gales. Ship heading to the westward.

Lat 46.57 S. Long 57.40 West

Tuesday November the 9th Day
First part fresh gales from N.N.W. Ship under double reefed top sails heading to the Westward. Middle part under short sail heading to the eastward. Latter part more moderate made all sail to the N.E.

Lat 46.55 South. Long 57.31 West
