

Remarks On Board Bark Isabella

Saturday November the 20th
First part fresh breezes from N.W. Ship under all sail. Course
S.B.E. by compass. Middle part moderate breezes. Latter part
fresh breezes from the Southward. with much rain. Ship
heading to the eastward.

Lat 53.30 South. Long 62.30 W.

Sunday November the 21st Day
First part light breezes & calm weather. Ship by the wind
heading to the S.W. Middle part light breezes from the
Northward. Course S.B.E. Latter part fresh breezes from N.W.
Course S.B.W. At 6 A.M. saw Staten Land bearing
S.W. by S. distant 45 miles by estimation

Lat 54.40 South. Long 63.00 W.

Monday November the 22^d
First part light breezes from the Southward. Staten
Land in sight. Central part bearing S.W. distant 20 miles
Middle part fresh breezes from S.E. Ship under all sail
heading S.B.W. Latter part wind the same. Ship heading to
the Southward. Saw a large ship standing to the
Westward.

Lat 55.53 South. Long 65.04 West

Tuesday November the 23^d Day
First part light breeze from the Southward. Ship under
all sail heading to the Westward. Saw Staten Land
to the N.W. Middle part strong gales from the Westward
Ship heading from S.S.E. to S.S.W. Latter part much
the same. Two ships in sight both bound to Westward

Lat 56.50 South Long 65.44 W.

Off Cape Horn November 1852

Wednesday November the 24th
First part strong gales from the Westward with heavy squalls
Ship under double reefed top sails heading from S.S.W. to S.S.E.
two ships in sight. Middle & last part much the same
close reefed the top sails & reefed the fore sail. At 9 A.M.
were ships to the Westward

Lat 57.38 South. Long 65.18 West

Thursday November the 25th Day
First part strong gales from N.S.W. took in the fore top sail &
fore sail. At 3 P.M. more moderate & set them again. Ship
heading W.N.W. Saw a ship standing the same. Middle part
moderate. Latter part strong gales again. were ship & headed
S.B.E.

Lat 58.58 S. Long 65.10 West

Friday November the 26th Day
First part strong gales from the Westward. Ship heading
S.B.E. by compass. Middle part moderate. Latter part fine
weather & light breezes from the Westward. Made all sail
heading south by compass. Lat 58.01 South. Long 65.26 West

Saturday November the 27th Day
First part light air from the Westward & pleasant. Ship
heading from S to S.W. Middle part the wind changed to the
Northward. Changed again to the Westward & blew fresh
double reefed the top sails. Latter part more moderate
made all sail to the S.W. ends with fog

Lat 58.53 S. Long 68.00 West

Sunday November the 28th Day
First part fresh gales from N.W. Ship heading S.W. by compass
under single reefed top sails with top gulant sails set over
them. Middle & last part strong gales. took in top gulant
sails. Wind to Westward

Lat 59.37 South Long 70.47 West
