Monday November the 29th Day
First part strong gales from the westward. Ship under double
reefed top sails heading to the s.w. Middle part at 7 P.M.
was ship to the northward. at 2 A.M. were round again
to the s.w. latter part light from s.w. Ship under all sail
Lat 59.47 South. Long 71.30 West

Tuesday November the 30th Day
First part light air from s.w. Ship under all sail heading
to the s.w. Middle & last part calm. with a large swell
from the westward
Lat 59.56 South. Long 72.19 West

Wednesday December the 1st Day
First part calm with a large swell from the westward
Middle part the same. latter part took a light breeze
from the northward. (made all sail. made all sail
course w. by compass.

Lat 59.45 South. Long 73.27 West

Thursday December the 2^d Day
First part pleasant weather & light breeze from the southward.
Ship under all sail course west by compass. Saw a bark ship
standing to the eastward. Middle part light breeze from the
westward & calm. latter part light breeze & pleasant weather
winds from the s.e. course w. by s. by compass

Friday December the 3^d Day
First part gentle breeze from s.e. with pleasant weather. Ship
under all sail course w. by s. Middle part fresh gales from s.e.
to south, course w. s. w. latter part light air from the southward.
Ship heading by the wind from w. by w. to w. by s.

Horn Bound To The Northward Nov. & Decem. 1832

Saturday December the 4th Day
First part light air from the southward. Ship under all sail
by the wind heading to the southward. Middle & last part
light air from the eastward. Ship under all sail course west
Lat 57.30 South. Long 81.46 West

Sunday December the 5th Day
First part fresh breeze from the eastward. Ship under all sail
course west by compass. Middle & last part fresh breeze from the
s.e. to s. course w. s. w. by compass.

Lat 55.20 South. Long 84.20 West

Monday December the 6th Day
First part fresh gales from the southward. Ship under all sail
course s.w. by w. Middle & last part much the same as first
part. course s.w. by compass.

Lat 52.49 South. Long 85.29 West

Tuesday December the 7th Day
First part fresh breeze from s.w. to w. Ship heading by the wind to the
northward. Middle part the wind changed to the n.w. latter part
strong gales. Ship heading n.w. e. under double reefed top sails. ends
with thick & rainy weather

First part strong gales from the westward. Ship under double
reefed top sails heading to the northward. Middle & last part
more moderate. Ship heading as above. Saw a large ship standing
to the northward
