

Bark Gabelin At Ahedo

Monday, March the 7th Day

Bark put fine weather. the pack on shore on liberty. Latter part fine weather but a large swell & too much surf on the bar of the river to get off. Latter the pack went on liberty. No sails

Tuesday, March the 8th

Bark put fine weather the pack on liberty. Latter part the same. No attempt to get off any water. got off some potatoes. & painted two of the boats

Wednesday, March the 9th

Bark put fine weather but much swell on. the pack on liberty. No attempt to get off water. got off some potatoes. the pack went on liberty.

Thursday, March the 10th

Bark put fine weather. the pack on liberty. employed on board getting up of potatoes & stowing them away. Latter part the pack went on liberty. got off some pumpkins & bananas

Friday, March the 11th

Bark put the pack on liberty. employed on board in ship's duty. in general. Latter part all hands on board got off a raft of water

Saturday, March the 12th

Bark put fine weather. all hands on board employed stowing water. Latter part got off a small raft of water all hands on board

Sunday, March the 13th

Bark put all hands on board but the Capt. waiting for wind to get to sea any thing being in readiness to sail. Latter part the same. Several ships made an attempt to get out but did not succeed. & was obliged to come to anchor.

Famurick Islands March 1853

Monday, March the 14th

Bark put fine weather but the wind not fair to get out. part of the men went on shore on liberty. Latter part the same

Tuesday, March the 15th

Bark put fine weather all hands on board. Shipped two natives & took them on board. no wind to get out. Latter part moved ship in a better place to get underway, in case we have to beat out with a head wind.

Wednesday, March the 16th

Bark put light trades with rain. all hands on board together with the Capt. & Pilot all waiting patiently for a wind to get underway. Latter part at 10 A.M. took the anchor & made all sail to beat out with the wind ahead. No sails

Thursday, March the 17th

Bark put light trades. Ship under all sail beating out out of the bay. at dusk got out all day. Middle part off & on. the pilot still on board. Latter part shot in & discharged the pilot

Friday, March the 18th

Bark put strong trades. Steaming to the westward. Middle part the same. double reefed the top sails. Latter part, passed in sight of Morae & Moratou to the northward of them.

Saturday, March the 19th

Bark put strong trade winds. passed between the islands of Morae & Moratou. at 3 P.M. bore to the windward of diamon head off Honohula. close reefed the top sails. Middle & last part lying off & on at Honohula. at 7 A.M. the Capt. went on shore. No sails
