Sunday March the 20th

First part strong trade ship off on at Honolulu. at 4 PM the boat came off. Made all sail & kept off before the wind to westward. Middle & last part fine weather & light trade. Course w. by s.

Lat 21.15. North. Long 159.58 West

Monday March the 21st Day

First part light trade winds & pleasant weather. Course w. by s. Middle & last part much the same. Stowed the anchors & chains. So ends

Lat 21.01. Long 162.38

Tuesday March the 22^d

First part light breeze from N.E. Ship under all sail course west by compass. Middle & last part course the same. Wind light from N.E. with pleasant weather. Saw a ship.

Lat 21.16. Long 163.38

Wednesday March the 23^d

First part light trade with a large swell. Course west. Employed mending the main sail. Middle part the wind changed to east with rain. Latter part fresh gale from the westward with rain

Lat 21.24. Long 166.48

Thursday March the 24th

First part fresh gales & squalls from the S.W. double reefed the top sails ship heading to the westward. Middle part strong gales with thunder lightning & rain from S.W. close reefed the top sails. Ship heading to S.W. Latter part much the same

Lat 22.42. Long 167.48

Friday March the 25th

First part calm squalls & buffing winds. Ship heading on different tracks by the wind under short sail. Middle & last part fresh gale from the westward ship heading by the wind to the westward under short sail

Lat 21.37. Long 167.22

Toward The Ochotsk Sea March 1858

Saturday March the 26th Day

First part fresh gale from the westward. Ship by the wind heading to the southward under short sail. Middle & last part light buffing winds from the westward. Ship by the wind sometimes on one tack & sometimes on the other. employed mending the fore top sail

Lat 21.30. Long 167.34

Sunday March the 27th

First part light air from the westward. Ship heading by the wind to the northward. employed mending the fore top sail. Middle & last part much the same. part of the time calm. Ship heading southward

Lat 21.10. Long 167.37

Monday March the 28th

First part light air from N.W. Ship by the wind heading to S.W. under all sail. Middle & last part light breeze from N.E. Course w. by N. by compass.

Lat 21.15. Long 169.39 west

Tuesday March the 29th

First part fresh breeze from N.E. with a large swell from N.E. Ship under all sail. Course w. by N. Middle & last part much the same

Lat 22.10. Long 171.59 west

Wednesday March the 30th

First part light trade winds with a large swell from N.E. Ship under all sail course w. by N. Middle & last part much the same as first.

Lat 23.01. Long 174.24

Thursday March the 31st Day

First part fresh breeze from east. Ship under all sail course N.E. Middle part the wind changed to S.E. Latter part changed again to South. Course N.W. ends with rain, cloudy weather.
