

Bank Isabella From The Sandwich Islands

Friday April the 1st Day

First part fresh breeze from S.W. with much rain ship heading W.S.W. Middle part light buffing, winds & rising. Latter part calm

Lat 24.33. Long 177.08 West

Saturday April the 2d Day

First part light breeze from the Southwest with calms. At 4 P.M. took a strong breeze from the Northwest. Middle & last part strong breeze from S.E. ship under close reefed top sails steering to the westward. passed the Manihua from West to East Longitude

Lat 24.43. Long 177.59 East

Sunday April the 3d Day

First part strong gale from S.E. with a heavy sea. Ship under close top sails reefed steering W.S.W. Middle & last part (more moderate). Course W.S.W. ship under close reefed top sails

Lat 26.04. Long 176.58 East

Monday April the 4th

First part fresh gale & squally weather. Ship under single reefed top sails & main top by sail. Course W.S.W. Middle & last part strong breeze from S.E. Course as above

Lat 27.30 North. Long 173.58 East

Tuesday April the 5th Day

First part fresh gale from S.W.E. Course W.S.W. by compass. Middle & last part wind E by N. Course W.W. employed breaking out between decks

Lat 29.21. Long 171.27 East

Wednesday April the 6th

First part fresh breeze from the Southwest ship under all sail course W.W. by W. Middle & last part much the same as first part

Lat 31.17. Long 169.20 East

Toward The Cohotek Sea April 1823

Thursday April the 7th

First part fresh breeze from the Southwest ship under all sail course W.W. by W. by compass. Saw whale fast. Middle & last part light air from S.E. & pleasant weather. Course as above. Sent down the main top sail to head

Lat 32.34. Long 167.55 East

Friday April the 8th Day

First part light air from S.E. Course W.W. by W. At 1 P.M. saw a whale (whale lowered all of the boats to no effect. kept off again to the S.W. Middle & last part light air from S.E. with fog. Course W.W. Saw black fish lowered to no effect

Saturday April the 9th Day

First part light air from the Southwest. Course W.W. Middle part calm & foggy. Latter part clear with light breeze from the Southwest. Course the same as first part

Lat 34.00 Long 166.01 East

Sunday April the 10th

First part light breeze & pleasant weather from the Southwest. Ship under all sail course W.W. Middle part foggy. Latter part fresh breeze from the Southwest & clear. Course as above ship under all sail.

Lat 36.18. Long 164.20

Monday April the 11th

First part fresh breeze from the Southwest with some fog. Course W.W. At 10 down double reefed the top sails. Middle part fresh gale from the Southwest ship heading Southwest by the wind. Latter part heading to the Northwest wind W.W.

Lat 38.18 Long 164.19 East

Tuesday April the 12th

First part light air from Northwest. ship heading to the Southwest middle part light air from S.E. Latter part fresh gale with thick fog. Course W.W.

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
