

Bark Isabella In The

Wednesday May the 4th Day
First part light breeze from the westward with a thick snow storm at 3 P.M. cleared up. Saw the passage between Unalaska & Baranofski but being to the westward could not fetch it. Middle & last part wind steady from N.W. Ship on different tacks working up for the passage with fine weather.

Thursday May the 5th Day
First part light breeze from N.W. Ship heading on different tacks beating up to westward. Middle part the wind changed to the eastward with much passed between the Islands & entered the Sea of Ochotsk. Latter part strong N.W. with thick fog, wind to eastward.

Friday May the 6th Day
First part fresh breeze from the westward with some fog. Ship heading to the northward. A ship in sight. Middle part light air & calms. Latter part calm.

Saturday May the 7th Day
First part light breeze from the westward. Ship heading to the westward by the wind. five ships in sight. Middle part took in top g. sails. Ship heading to the eastward. Latter part triced & stood to the westward with fine weather.

Sunday May the 8th
First part light breeze & fine weather from the westward. Ship under all sail heading N.W.E. Middle part light air. Latter part light air & calm weather. one ship in sight.

Monday May the 9th
First part calm. with a large swell from the northward. Two ships in sight. Middle & last part calm. A ship & a bark in sight.

Ochotsk Sea May 1853

Tuesday May the 10th Day
First part light air from the northward. Ship heading to the westward under all sail. Spoke Sarah Vernon of New Bedford 1300 Bbls. Middle part strong breeze. double reefed the top sails heading N.W. Latter part light breeze. triced & stood to the N.E.

Wednesday May the 11th
First part fresh gales from N.W. Ship under all sail heading N.E. Saw a ship to leeward. Middle part heading from N.W. to N.E. wind to the northward. Latter part heading to westward wind the same.

Thursday May the 12th
First part fresh breeze from the northward with some snow. Ship heading to the N.E. Middle & last part heading to the westward by the wind. Saw a bark heading the same.

Friday May the 13th
First part fresh breeze from the northward. Ship heading to the westward under all sail. At 6 P.M. saw field ice. Middle part heading to eastward under short sail. Latter part made all sail to the N.W. two ships in sight.

Saturday May the 14th
First part light air & pleasant from the northward. Ship under all sail heading to the N.W. Saw two ships also saw Southey ice at 4 P.M. triced to the eastward. Middle & last part light air & fine weather. wind N.W. Ship heading from N. to N.E.

Sunday May the 15th
First part light air from the northward & fine weather. Ship heading to the westward under all sail. A ship in sight. Middle & last part light air. Ship by the wind on different tacks. Saw field ice. two ships in sight.
