

Bank Isabella Toward The Sandwich Islands

Sunday Sept 25th

First part strong breezes and rugged with rain. Ship under all sail course South by compass. Two ships in sight. Middle and last part light air from the northward. Ship under all sail course South.

Lat 33.30 Long 153.27 East

Monday Sept 26th

First part light air from the northward. Ship under all sail course South. Middle part calm. Latter part fresh breezes from S.E. with thick rising weather. Ship heading by the wind to the S.W. under all sail. Lat 32.30 N. Long 152.21

Tuesday Sept 27th

First part light air from the westward and fine weather. Ship under all sail course S. by E. Saw a ship standing to the southward. Middle and last part strong breezes from N.E. with rain. Ship under all sail course S.E. Saw a ship steering the same.

Lat 31.29 Long 153.16

Wednesday Sept 28th

First part strong gales from N.W. Ship under all sail course S.E. Middle part strong gales at 10 P.M. judging the land to be not far distant here to under short sail heading on different tacks by the wind. At day light made sail and light off to the southward. Saw the land. One of the small islands which forms the passage between Ochoyok and Paganusur Islands. Entered the passage. Over all ships in sight all bound through.

Thursday Sept 29th

First part strong gales from N.W. Ship under all sail steering E by South in the passage between Ochoyok and Paganusur. Middle part light breezes from N.W. course E by S ship under all sail. Latter part fresh breezes course as above three sail in sight. Lat 49.22 Long 158.52

Friday Sept 30th

First part strong gales from N.W. Ship under all sail course E by South by compass. Middle and last part strong breezes from the northward course as above. Two ships in sight.

Lat 48.23 Long 162.38

From Ochotsk Sea Sept. And Oct. 1823

Saturday Oct the 1st Day

First part strong breezes from the northward. Ship under all sail course E by S. Middle part light air. Latter part light air from the eastward and fine weather. Ship heading to the N.E. by the wind. Lat 47.27 Long 164.25 East

Sunday Oct 2d Day

First part light air from the eastward. Ship under all sail heading by the wind to the N.E. Middle and last part strong breezes from the southward. Ship by the wind heading E by N.

Lat 47.57 North

Monday Oct 3d

First part strong breezes from the southward. Ship under all sail course E by N employed cleaning bone. Middle and last part wind the same course East.

Lat 48.38

Tuesday Oct 4th

First part fresh breezes from S.E. Ship by the wind heading East under all sail. Middle and last part the same. ends with strong breezes. took in the top by sails.

Wednesday Oct 5th

First part strong breezes with fog from S.E. Employed cleaning bone. Middle part strong gales. Close reefed the top sails. Latter part more moderate. wind from S.W. made all sail. ends with thick fog.

Thursday Oct 6th

First part strong breezes from S.W. with thick fog. Ship under all sail course E by South employed cleaning bone. Middle and last part fresh breezes from W. to S.W. with thick fog.

Friday Oct 7th

First part fresh breezes from the westward with thick fog. Ship under all sail course E by South. Employed cleaning bone. Middle and last part fresh breezes from W. to N.W. Ship under all sail course East.
