Wednesday Novem 23rd

First part strong gales from S.W. Ship under double reefed top sails standing. Last middle and last part much the same. Lat 30.26. Long 132.23

Thursday Novem 24th

First part strong gales from S.W. Course last by compass. Ship under double reefed top sails. Middle and last part the same. Course E. by N. Ship under close reefed top sails. Lat 30.52. Long 132.30

Friday Novem 25th

First part strong gales from the westward. Ship under close reefed top sails. Course E. by N. Middle and last part much the same. Set whole top sails. Lat 30.39. Long 129.48

Saturday Novem 26th

First part strong gales from the westward. At sun down double reefed the top sails. Course E. by N. Middle and last part more moderate. (Made all sails) Course as above. Ends with fine weather. Lat 29.25. Long 127.47

Sunday Novem 27th

First part light breezes from W. by N. with much swell. Ship under all sail. Course S. E. by E. One sail standing to the northward. Middle part the wind changed to the north. Latter part light breezes from the N.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail. Course S. E. by E. Lat 28.19. Long 126.57

Monday Novem 28th

First part light breezes from N. E. Ship under all sail by the wind heading, S. E. Middle and last part light airs from east. Ship heading, S. E. by E. Ends with much cloudy weather. No fish

Tuesday Novem 29th

First part light airs from the eastward with cloudy weather. Ship under all sail heading, S. E. by the point. Middle and last part much the same. Spoke the steamer Albatross from New York bound to St. Francisco. put letters on board of her. Lat 28.57

Wednesday Novem 30th

First part light breezes from the eastward and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to the northward. Middle and last part light breezes from N. E. Course S. E. Lat 33.49. Long 122.36 West

Thursday Decem 1st Day

First part light breezes from N. E. Ship under all sail standing, S. E. by S. Saw a ship standing to the northward. Middle and last part light breezes from E. to N. E. Course as above. Lat 21.52. Long 124.46

Friday Decem 2nd

First part light breezes from E. to N. E. Ship under all sail. Course S. E. by E. Middle and last part the same as first part. Lat 20.12. Long 124.50

Saturday Decem 3rd

First part light breezes from the northward. Ship under all sail. Course S. E. by E. Middle and last part light-buffing winds from E. to N. E. and fine weather. Course the same. Lat 19.25. Long 124.32

Sunday Decem 4th

First part light breezes from the eastward and fine weather. Ship under all sail. Course S. E. by E. Middle and last part fresh breezes from N. Course the same as first part. Lat 16.17. Long 124.56

Monday Decem 5th

First part fresh breezes from N. Course S. E. by E. Ship under all sail. Middle part the same. Latter part fresh breezes from N. E. with rain squalls. Ends with light air. Lat 14.06. Long 124.38

Tuesday Decem 6th

First part light breezes from N. E. Ship under all sail. Course S. E. by E. Middle and last part light airs from E. Ship by the wind heading, S. E. by E. Lat 13.05. Long 124.35

Wednesday Decem 7th

First part light airs from east. Ship under all sail heading, S. E. by the point. Middle and last part light breezes from N. E. and fine weather. Saw porpoises and fish. Lat 11.21. Long 123.27 West
