Thursday Decem 22nd

First part strong breeze from N.E. with much rain steering S.W. under close reefed top sails. at dusk hauled to the wind head to the South. Middle part under short sail latter part more moderate made some sail to the westward. ends with cloudy weather. M.O.

Friday Decem 23rd

First part fresh breeze from N.E. with dark clouds squally weather. steering to the S.W. at sun down shortened sail and hove to head to the South. Middle and last part fine weather. made sail to the Southward. Lat 7.48. Long 131.52

Saturday Decem 24th

First part light breeze from N.E. and fine weather steering South. At sun down shortened sail. Middle part heading to the Eastward under short sail. latter part made sail and kept off to the Southward. Lat 7.17. Long 131.26

Sunday Decem 25th

First part light breeze from N.E. and squally weather. at sun down shortened sail for the night. Middle and last part light baffling winds dark squally weather with rain. made sail at day light and steered to the Southward. M.O.

Monday Decem 26th

First part fresh breeze from the northward. steering S.W. at sun down shortened sail and hove to head to the Westward. Middle and last part baffling winds squally and dark rainy weather. M.O.

Tuesday Decem 27th

First part light breeze from the westward. Ship heading to the Southward. at sun down shortened sail. Middle part strong gales with much rain from N.W. latter part more moderate. made some sail. Ship heading to the westward. ends with fine weather

Wednesday Decem 28th

First part fresh breeze from N.W. Ship heading to the Westward. at sun down shortened sail for the night. Middle part heading to the Eastward under short sail light breeze and fine weather from the northward. latter part the same made sail at day light to the westward. Lat 6.47. Long 133.11

Whale Cruise December And January 1852 and 1854

Thursday December 29th

First part light breeze from the northward with fine weather. Ship heading to the westward under all sail. at sun down shortened sail. Middle part the same Ship heading on different tacks under short sail. latter part made all sail heading N.W. Lat 7.40. Long 133.13

Friday Decem 30th

First part light breeze from N.E. Ship under all sail heading N.W. at sun down shortened sail. Middle part by the wind on different tacks. latter part made all sail and kept off S.S.W. fine weather wind N.E. Lat 8.09. Long 133.38

Saturday Decem 31st

First part light breeze from N.E. and fine weather steering S.W. under all sail. at sun down took in sail. Middle and last part wind and weather the same. at day light made all sail to the westward. Lat 7.52. Long 134.00

Sunday Decem or January the 1st Day 1854

First part fresh breeze from E.S.E. steering to the westward. at sun down took in sail. Middle and last part strong breezes and rugged. wind N.E. Ship under short sail heading E.S.E. Lat 7.25. Long 133.20

Monday Jan 2nd

First part strong breezes from N.E. Ship under short sail heading E.S.E. Middle and last part heading to the N.W. wind and weather the same as first part. A strong current hereabouts setting to the N.E. Lat 7.34. Long 133.10 West

Tuesday Jan 3rd

First part strong breezes from N.E. Ship under close reefed top sails heading E.S.E. Middle and last part strong breezes squally and rainy weather. Ship under short sail heading to the N.W. Lat 8.00. Long 132.50

Wednesday Jan 4th

First part strong breezes squally and rainy weather. Ship under close reefed top sails steering South. Middle part heading to the N.W. the weather the same as first part latter part more moderate made all sail fresh breezes from N.E. current S.S.W. Lat 7.50 N. Long 132.37 West
