Wednesday February 1st

First part light breezes from E.N.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to the northward. At sun down took in sail. Middle and last part fresh breezes. At midnight wore ship to the S.E. At day light made all sail
Lat 7.42. Long 136.11.

Thursday Feb 2d.

First part fresh breezes from E.S.E. Ship under all sail steering to the westward. At sun down took in sail. Middle part squally rainy weather. Latter part the same. At day light wore ship to the southward and made some sail ends with light breezes

Friday Feb 3d.

First part light breezes from the eastward with occasionally a rain squall. Ship under all sail heading to the southward. Middle part the same ship under short sail. Latter part made sail and kept off N.W. fresh breezes from E.S.E. and squally
Lat 7.28. Long 136.39

Saturday Feb 4th

First part fresh breezes from E.S.E. Ship under all sail steering N.W. at sun down took in sail. Middle part under short sail heading to the north squally and rainy. Latter part the same at day light made some sail and kept off S.W.
Lat 8.03 Long 136.33

Sunday Feb 5th

First part squally and rainy from S.E. steering to the northward. At sun down took in sail. Middle and last part light breezes from the southward and fine weather. Steering N.E. At day light made all sail.
Lat 8.44. Long 136.33

Monday Feb 6th

First part calm and fine weather. At dark took in sail. Middle part fresh breezes from E.N.E. with some rain. Latter part light airs and fine weather at day light made all sail and wore ship to the northward.
Lat 8.40. Long 136.33

Tuesday Feb 7th

First part light breezes from E.N.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to the northward. At sun down took in sail. Middle and last part light breezes with occasionally a rain squall. Ends with fine weather ship under all sail

Whale Cruise February 1854

Wednesday Feb 8th.

First part light breezes from E.N.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to the northward. At dark took in sail. Middle and last part heading the same. At day light made all sail under strong trades
Lat 10.55. Long 137.07

Thursday Feb 9th.

First part strong trades ship heading to the northward under whole top sails. At sun down took in sail. Middle and last part fresh trades at day light set whole top sails heading N.W.E.
Lat 12.21 Long 137.29

Friday Feb 10th.

First part fresh trades ship under easy sail heading N.W.E. Saw fin backs. At sun down took in sail. Middle and last part light breezes and fine weather. Wind last. Ship heading to the northward under all sail. Made sail at day light.
Lat 13.51. Long 138.07

Saturday Feb 11th

First part light breezes from the eastward and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to the northward. Sent down the main top sail to mend. Took in sail at sun down. Middle and last part much the same as first part.
Lat 14.22. Long 138.27

Sunday Feb 12th

First part light breezes from the eastward and fine weather. Ship heading to the northward under all sail. Took in sail at sun down. Middle part strong trades. Latter part the same. At day light set the fore top sail and kept off W. by N. Ends with cloudy weather

Monday Feb 13th

First part strong trades. Ship under double reefed top sails course W. by N. Middle and last part strong trades. Course the same. Ends with strong gales and rain
Lat 16.01 North

Tuesday Feb 14th

First part strong gales from N.E. with rain. Ship under double reefed top sails course W. by N. Middle and last part more moderate set the main top g. sail course the same as first part
Lat 16.41. Long 144.41
