Wednesday Feb. 15th

First part strong trades. Ship under all sail course w. by n. Employed mending the main top sail. Middle part strong gales from east. Latter part baffling winds and calm. with a large swell. Course w. by n. Lat 17.09. Long 146.55

Thursday Feb. 16th

First part light trades. Course w. by n. Employed mending the main top sail Middle and last part strong trades course as above. finished mending the main top sail Lat 17.38. Long 148.53

Friday Feb. 17th

First part strong trades. Course w. by n. Ship under all sail. Middle and last part the same. Sent down the fore sail to mend and bent another one Lat 18.46. Long 152.19

Saturday Feb. 18th

First part strong trades. Ship under all sail course w. by n. Employed mending the fore sail. Middle and last part wind and course the same as first part. Lat 19.23. Long 154.29

Sunday February 19th Day

First part light trades and fine weather. Course w. by n. At sundown saw the South end of Oryhe distant 10 miles. Middle part baffling winds ship by the wind in different tracks heading off and on shore. Latter part at 9 A.M. took a pilot and stood in for Hilo

Monday Feb. 20th

First part fine weather. At 1 P.M. anchored in the port of Hilo. Last part fine weather. All hands employed getting off water. Leaving ship out side breaking out 16.

Tuesday Feb. 21st

First part fine weather. All hands employed getting off water and stowing it down. Latter part the same.

Sandwich Islands February 1854

Wednesday Feb. 22nd

First part fine weather. All hands employed getting off water and stowing it down. Latter part fine weather. Employed painting ship getting off wood and setting up sheels for water.

Thursday Feb. 23rd

First part fine weather. All hands employed painting ship and getting off wood. Latter part rainy weather. One wash went on shore on liberty. The other employed cutting up and stowing the wood away.

Friday Feb. 24th

First part rainy weather. One wash on liberty. Employed on board cutting up the wood and stowing it away. Latter part frequent showers of rain. The other wash went on liberty. got off a raft of water.

Saturday Feb. 25th

First part rainy weather. One wash on liberty. Employed on board stowing water and wood. Latter part the same.

Sunday Feb. 26th

First part employed stowing water. One wash on liberty. Latter part fine weather. the wash on liberty.

Monday Feb. 27th

First part fine weather. One wash on liberty. Latter part much rain. the wash on liberty.

Tuesday Feb. 28th

First part rainy and fresh trade winds. the wash on liberty. Latter part much the same.

Wednesday Feb. March 1st Day

First part fine weather. One wash on shore on liberty. Latter part the same. Employed painting ship.
