Wednesday April 12th

First part fresh trade winds and fine weather. Ship under all sail course W. by S. Middle and last part the same. Lat 21.00. Long 177.45. East

Thursday April 13th

First part strong trade winds and fine weather. Course W. by N. Middle and last part light breezes from E.S.E. and fine weather. Spoke the Sac. Ships of New London, also the bark. Shepherds of Mystic. Lat 21.55. Long 174.43 East

Friday April 14th

First part light breezes from East with rain. Ship under all sail course West. the bark. Ships and Shepherds in company. Middle and last part light breezes from E.S.E. and fine weather. Course W. by N. Lat 23.00 Long 172.23

Saturday April 15th

First part light breezes from E.S.E. and fine weather. Course W. by N. Ship under all sail. Middle and last part the same. Lat 24.11. Long 170.30

Sunday April 16th

First part fine weather and gentle breezes from East. Course W. by N. Ship under all sail. Middle and last part much the same. Lat 25.07. Long 168.57

Monday April 17th

First part light breezes from East and fine weather. Ship under all sail course W. by N. employed heaving out between decks. Middle and last part light airs from E.S.E. with frequent rain squalls. Lat 26.11. Long 167.40 East

Tuesday April 18th

First part light airs from S.E. course W. by N. Ship under all sail. Middle and last part much the same. Lat 27.22. Long 165.48

Wednesday April 19th Day

First part light airs from S.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail course W. by N. Middle and last part light airs from the Southward. Course N. by W. Lat 28.32 Long 164.53

Thursday April 20th

First part light airs from S.W. and calm. Middle and last part fresh breezes from E.S.E. with rain. Course N. by W. Ship under all sail. Lat 29.25 Long 163.57

Friday April 21st

First part fresh breezes from E.S.E. Course N. by W. by compass. Ship under all sail. Middle and last part fresh breezes from S.S.W. with thick fog. M. O.

Saturday April 22nd

First part fresh breezes from S.W. with fog. Ship under all sail course N. by W. Middle and last part strong breezes from W. Ship by the wind heaving N. by W. Lat 33.40. Long 162.32 East

Sunday April 23rd

First part strong breezes from the Westward and rugged weather. Took in top g. sails and doubled reefed the top sails. Ship heading from N. to N. by the wind. Middle and last part more moderate. Made home sail. Lat 32.46. Long 162.42

Monday April 24th

First part light buffing winds and calm, with a large swell from the Westward. Ship heading northerly. Middle and last part strong gales with much rain from S.E. to E.S.E. Course N. by W. M. O.

Tuesday April 25th

First part fresh breezes from the Eastward with rain. Ship heading to the Northward. Middle part the wind changed to the S.W. with rain. Course N. by W. Middle part fresh breezes from West and fine weather. Made all sail. Lat 37.24. Long 161.02 East
