

Remarks on the passage from Chatham Sea towards

Thursday Oct 19th Day
First part fresh breezes from W. Ship under all sail. Course E. by N. Middle and last part the same. Do ends
Lat 47.40. Long 177.58 West

Friday Oct 20th

First part fresh breezes from W. Ship under all sail. Course E. by N. Mending the main top g. sail. Middle part the wind changed to last with strong breezes. took in the top g. sails. Latter part strong gales. double reefed the top sails. Ship heading S. E. by the wind. ends with cloudy weather. took in the lower part

Saturday Oct 21st Day

First part strong gales from East. close reefed the top sails and took in the fore sail. At 3 P.M. wore ship to the northward. At dark took in the fore top sail. Middle and last part strong gales. Ship under short sail heading to the northward ends with rain

Sunday Oct 22d.

First part strong gales from the Eastward with roused weather and rain. Ship under short sail heading to the Southward. Middle part calm. Latter part light airs from S. S. W. with a large swell from the Eastward. Made all sail to the Eastward. ends with thick fog

Monday Oct 23d

First part light breezes from S. S. W. with fog. A large swell from the Eastward. Ship under all sail. Course E. by S. Middle part strong breezes. took in top g. sails. Latter part strong gales with rain. At 11 A.M. the wind changed suddenly to W. and cleared up
Lat 48.19. Long 172.58 West

Tuesday Oct 24th Day

First part strong gales from W. Ship under all sail. Course E. by S. Middle and last part light airs and fine weather. Course E. S. E. by compass
Lat 48.46. Long 170.18 W.

Friday Oct 25th Day Wednesday 25th

First part light airs from S. W. and fine weather. Course E. S. E. Middle part fresh breezes. took in top g. sails. Latter part strong gales with much rain. double reefed the top sails and took in the courses. ends with the wind W. S. W. Course last blowing heavy. Ship under close reefed top sails
Lat 48.18. Long 187.40

Thursday Oct 26th

First part strong gales from W. S. W. Ship under double reefed top sails. Course E. by S. At 4 P.M. more moderate to the main top g. sail. Middle part fine weather. Made all sail. Latter part wind W. Course E. S. E.
Lat 41.57. Long 188.11

Friday Oct 27th Day

First part light breezes from W. and fine weather. Course E. S. E. Ship under all sail. Middle and last part light airs from W. S. W. Course as above
Lat 40.25. Long 185.46

Saturday Oct. 28th Day

First part light baffling winds. Course E. S. E. Middle part fresh breezes from the Southward. Ship under all sail. Latter part strong gales from S. to S. W. with rain. double reefed the top sails. ends with cloudy weather.

First part strong breezes squally and rains from S. W. Ship under double reefed top sails. Course E. S. E. Middle and last part fine weather. Made all sail. Course S. E. by E.

Monday Oct 30th

First part fresh breezes from W. W. and fine weather. Ship under all sail. Course S. E. by E. Middle part wind N. W. E. Latter part the same
Lat 36.16 North

Tuesday Oct 31st Day

First part fresh breezes from W. W. E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail. Course S. E. by E. Middle and last part wind W. Latter part strong gales
Lat 33.38 Long 184.89
