Saturday December 30th Day

First part wind N.W. E and fine weather. Ship heading S.E. employed boiling. Saw a sail standing to the southward. Middle and last part wind N.E. Ship heading E.S.E. at day light finished boiling and made all sail
Lat 21.22. Long 149.15

Sunday December 31st.

First part light breezes from N.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading E.S.E. Middle and last part light breezes from N.W. E Ship heading East under all sail
Lat 22.20. Long 147.30

Monday December. January 1st Day

First part light breezes from N.W. E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail. Course set by compass. Middle and last part light breezes with occasionally squalls of rain. Ship heading to the eastward
Lat 23.31. Long 148.52

Tuesday January 2d Day

First part baffling winds and calm with occasionally a squall of rain. Ship under all sail heading eastward. Middle part much the same. Latter part fresh breezes with squalls from the eastward. Ship heading S.S.W. under easy sail
At 10.

Wednesday January 3d. Day

First part strong breezes from the eastward. Ship by the wind heading S.S.W. at Sun down double reefed the top sails Middle and last part strong breezes from S.E. Ship under double reefed top sails heading S.S.W.
Lat 24.44. Long 146.27

Thursday January 4th

First part strong breezes from S.E. to E. Ship under single reefed top sails heading from S.S.W. to E. Middle and last part light breezes from East Ship heading Southward at day light Made all sail
Lat 26.12.3. Long 146.37.

Friday January 5th

First part light breezes from N.W. E. Ship heading S.E. under all sail. Middle part baffling winds and rain with heavy thunder. Latter part fresh breezes from East and fine weather. Made all sail heading S.S.W.
Lat 26.29. Long 146.20

Saturday January 6th Day 1852

First part light breezes from N.W. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading E.S.E. Middle and last part much the same. At ends
Lat 27.34. Long 145.20

Sunday Jan. 7th Day

First part fresh breezes from N.E. and squalls Middle and latter part much the same. Ship under all sail heading heading from S.E. by E. to E. by S.
Lat 29.04. Long 145.24

Monday Jan. 8th

First part fresh breezes from N.E. Ship under all sail heading E.S.E. at 7 P.M. the wind changed to N.W. with rain. Course E by S. Middle and last part wind N.E. again. Ship by the wind heading E.S.E.
Lat 30.07. Long 140.50

Tuesday Jan. 9th Day

First part fresh N.E. winds and cloudy weather. Ship under all sail heading E.S.E. Middle part the same. Latter part strong breezes from the top by sails. Ship heading E by S.
Lat 31.23. Long 137.34

Wednesday Jan. 10th

First part strong breezes from N.W. E. Ship heading by the wind E by S. Middle part the same. Latter part strong breezes from N. Ship heading E by S.
Lat 32.13. Long 136.55

Thursday Jan. 11th

First part strong breezes from N. Ship under all sail heading E by N. Middle and last part fresh breezes from N.W. E. Course E.N.E.
Lat 32.22. Long 134.20

Friday Jan 12th

First part fresh breezes from N.W. E. Course E.N.E. Middle and last part much the same. Single reefed the top sails
Lat 32.12. Long 131.55

Saturday Jan 13th

First part strong breezes from N. Course E.N.E. at Sun down more moderate set the top sails. Middle and last part fine weather. Ship under all sail heading E.N.E. Stowed down some sperm oil in the run
Lat 32.02. Long 129.12
