

Remarks Off Marquesas Islands February 1853

Sunday Feb. 11th

First part light breezes from N.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to the N.W. at sun down shortened sail. Middle and last part heading to the N.W. Made all sail at day light fresh breezes from N.W. and fine weather
Lat 7.22. Long 133.24

Monday Feb. 12th

First part fresh breezes from N.W. Ship heading to the northward. at sun down single reefed the top sails. Middle and last part strong breezes. Ship heading northward
Lat 3.51 Long 132.23

Tuesday Feb. 13th

First part fresh breezes from N.W. and fine weather. Ship heading N by compass. Middle part the same. Latter part light breezes and fine weather. heading N.E. Saw cow fish
Lat 4.28. Long 132.15

Wednesday Feb. 14th

First part light airs from east and fine weather. Ship under all sail. Course N.E. Middle and last part light breezes from N.W. Ship heading to the N.W. Saw bark Ship heading to the southward.
Lat 3.47

Thursday Feb. 15th

First part light airs from the eastward calm and fine weather. Spoke the Hercules of New Bedford with 650 Bbls of sperm oil. Middle and last part heading to the N.W. under all sail
Lat 3.06 South Long 133.22 west

Friday Feb. 16th

First part light breezes from east and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to the northward. at sun down tacked to the southward. Middle and last part fresh breezes. Ship heading S by E. under all sail. Saw nothing
Lat 4.06. Long 133.16

Saturday Feb. 17th

First part fresh breezes from E.S.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading S by E. at sun down double reefed the top sails. Middle and last part heading the same. at day light made all sail
Lat 3.27. Long 133.35

Sunday Feb. 18th

First part light breezes from east and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading N.W. at dark double reefed the top sails. Middle and last part light breezes and fine weather. at day light made all sail heading to the southward
Lat 6.01. Long 133.38 west

Monday Feb. 19th

First part light breezes from east. Ship heading to the southward at dark took in sail. Middle and last part much the same Made all sail at day light
Lat 7.12 Long 134.03

Tuesday Feb. 20th Day

First part light breezes from east and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading S.S.W. at dark double reefed the top sail. Middle part light breezes. Latter part strong trade. Ship heading S by E.
Lat 8.38. Long 134.14

Wednesday Feb. 21st Day

First part strong trades. Ship heading S by E. under easy sail at dark took in the main sail and double reefed the top sails. Middle and last part much the same
Lat 10.15

Thursday Feb. 22d

First part strong trades Ship under easy sail heading S by E. Middle and last part much the same. at day light set main sail and etc.
Lat 11.58. Long 134.40

Friday Feb. 23d

First part fresh breezes from east. Ship heading S by E. at dark took in sail for the night and wore ship to northward. Middle and last part heading to the southward. at day light made sail
Lat 11.58

Saturday Feb. 24th

First part fresh breezes and fine weather. Ship under all sail steering S.W. at dark took in sail. Middle part under easy sail heading to northward Latter part at day light made all sail and kept off N.W.
Lat 11.55 Long 136.01 west
