

From Marquesas Islands Toward Otaheite

Sunday March 25th Day

First part strong trades. Ship under double reefed top sails. Middle and last part much the same. Lat 10.51. Long 144.41

Monday March 26th

First part fresh trades. Made all sail. Course S.W. at sundown double reefed the top sails. Middle part much the same. Latter part light trades. Made all sail at day light. Lat 11.51.3. Long 146.17.11

Tuesday March 27th

First part light trades and fine weather. Course S.W. at dark shortened sail. Middle and last part the same as first. at day light made all sail. Lat 12.49. Long 147.37

Wednesday March 28th

First part light trades and fine weather. Course S.W. Ship under all sail at dark shortened sail. Middle and last part the same. at day light made sail. Lat 13.25. Long 149.08

Thursday March 29th

First part light trades and fine weather. Ship under all sail. Course S.W. Saw a ship standing to the northward. Middle part under that sail by the wind on different tacks. There being a small island hereabouts on the chart. Latter part at day light made all sail heading by the wind S.W. by E. Saw nothing of the island. Lat 14.45. Long 149.52

Friday March 30th Day

First part light airs from E.S.E. and fine weather. Ship by the wind under all sail heading S.W. by E. Middle and last part much the same. Lat 15.40. Long 149.38

Saturday March 31st Day

First part light airs from E.S.E. and fine weather. Ship by the wind heading to the southward. Middle part light buffing winds and calm weather. Latter part light airs from S.W. Ship heading to the S.E. under all sail. Lat 15.21. Long 149.31

Homeward Bound March 1855

Sunday April 1st Day

First part light airs from E.S.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to the S.E. Middle part light airs and calm. Latter part light airs from S.W. and fine weather. Course S.S.E. Lat 16.09. Long 149.19

Monday April 2nd Day

First part light airs from S.W. and fine weather. Course S.S.E. Ship under all sail. Middle part much the same. Latter part light airs from S.W. and fine weather. Saw Otaheite bearing S.S.W. also Imao. passed to the eastward of them. Lat 17.10. Long 148.43

Tuesday April 3rd Day

First part light airs from S.W. and fine weather. Course S.E. by S. Otaheite and Imao both in sight to the westward. Middle and last part light airs from S.E. and fine weather. Course S.W. by E. Lat 18.45. Long 148.31

Wednesday April 4th

First part light breezes from E.N.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail. Course S.W. by E. Middle and last part much the same. Wind S.W. by E. Lat 20.00. Long 148.08

Thursday April 5th

First part light breezes from E and fine weather. Ship by the wind heading S.E. Middle and last part light airs from E.N.E. and fine weather. Ship by the wind heading S.E. Lat 21.03. Long 147.59

Friday April 6th

First part light airs from E.N.E. and fine weather. heading by the wind S.E. Middle and last part light airs from S.W. and fine weather. Course S.E. by E. Lat 21.38. Long 147.18

Saturday April 7th

First part light airs from S.W. and fine weather. Course S.E. by E. Middle part light buffing winds from S.W. to S.W. with some rain. Latter part fresh breezes from S.W. Lat 22.32. Long 145.49
