

From Oahu. Toward Cape Horn April 1835

Wednesday April 18th Day

First part calm. Middle and last part the same. Ends with light airs from S.E. and fine weather. Made all sail to S.S.W. *W. O.*

Thursday April 19th

First part light breezes from S.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading S.W. by S. Middle and last part fresh breezes from the Southward. Course S.S.E. Lat 38.20

Friday April 20th

First part light breezes from S. Course S.S.E. at 4 P.M. strong breezes and rain took in the top g. sails. Middle part changeable winds with rain. Latter part light breezes from the Southward and fine weather. Ship heading Eastward. Lat 38.41. Long 142.11

Saturday April 21st

First part light breezes from S.E. and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to the Eastward. Middle part the wind changed to the Eastward. Latter part strong breezes from the same. double reefed the top sails heading Southward. Lat 38.28

Sunday April 22^d

First part strong breezes from S.E. Ship heading S.S.W. under single reefed top sails. Middle part the wind changed to South. tacked ship and headed to the Eastward. Latter part much the same. Ship under all sail. Lat 38.00 Long 141.48

Monday April 23^d

First part strong breezes from the Southward and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to Eastward. Middle part light airs. Latter part much the same. Ship heading S.S.E. Lat 38.10. Long 140.36

Tuesday April 24th

First part light airs from the Southward and fine weather. Ship under all sail heading to Eastward. At 4 P.M. the wind changed to the Eastward. tacked to the Southward. Middle and last part wind light from S.E. to S. Ship heading by the wind to Southward. Saw a brig standing to Southward. Lat 38.13. Long. ...

Wednesday April 25th Day

First part light airs from S.E. to S. Ship heading Southward. at 4 P.M. the wind changed to S.W. by S. Course S.W. by S. Middle and last part much the same. Ends with fresh breezes. Lat 37.16. Long 139.51

Thursday April 26th Day

First part strong breezes from S.W. and fine weather. Course S.S.E. Ship under all sail. Middle part fresh breezes from W. Course East. Latter part wind S.W. with rain. *W. O.*

Friday April 27th

First part strong breezes from S.W. with some rain. Course S. under all sail. Middle and last part light breezes and fine weather. Lat 38.24. Long 138.26

Saturday April 28th

First part light breezes from S.W. and fine weather. Course East under all sail. Middle part strong breezes. Latter part strong breezes from S.S.E. Course S.W. by N. Lat 38.21. Long 130.30

Sunday April 29th

First part strong gales from S.S.E. took in top g. sails. at 4 P.M. double reefed the top sails. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate. Ship under single reefed top sails and main top g. sail. Ship heading East. Lat 38.08. Long 127.43

Monday April 30th

First part strong gales from S.S.E. Ship under single reefed top sails heading S. Middle part more moderate. Made all sail. Latter part fresh gales and fine weather. Wind S.S.W. Course East. Ship under all sail. Lat 38.08. Long 125.08

Tuesday May 1st Day

First part fresh breezes from W. S.W. and fine weather. Ship under all sail Course S.W. by S. Middle and last part strong breezes from W. by S. and equally. Course S.W. by S. *W. O.*
