 top sails Course E. S. W. Middle part much the same. Latter part more moderate

First part strong breezes from S. S. W. Course E. S. Middle part the wind changed
 to W. N. W. and moderated. Made all sail. Latter part strong breezes from W. N. W.
 with foggy weather. Ship under all sail course S. E.
