first part strong breeze from the S.E. at 11 a.m. by the wind and went to the latter moderate breeze from the S. with fog by the wind on different tacks Run the Brig off in company with the Abbott Lawrence and passed between Kinkaid and Mill

Island School See mill Island light breeze from the S.E. with clear weather Steering N.W. Saw Nottingham Island at 6 P.M. Saw Seahorse Point South Amster Island Baring about N.W. by compass

light breeze from the S. Steering N.W. & S. Cape Pembroke being S. north shore and the Abbott Lawrence in sight

Wednesday Aug 9th

light breeze from the S. with clear weather Steering N.W. land and the Abbott Lawrence in sight passed Walrus Island at 6 a.m.

Thursday Aug 10th

moderate breeze from the N.W. with clear weather Steering from N.W. to N.E. at 7 P.M. Whale point and Cape Sullivan and Abbott Lawrence in sight

Friday Aug 11th

light breeze from the N.W. with clear weather Brig by the wind on different tacks Whale point point in sight Samming with the Abbott Lawrence and the A. I. Ross.

Saturday Aug 10th

light breeze from S.W. to N.W. two Brigs and land Whale point at 5 P.M. Steering W & S. Bound for Marble Island foggy weather

Sunday Aug 11th

light breeze from N to N.W. Steering W & S. and by the wind damaged the Abbott Lawrence A. I. Ross saw the Chamer Cotton and land

Monday Aug 12th

light breeze from the N.E. at 3 a.m. P.M. anchored at Marble Island in the outer harbor the A. I. Ross and Abbott Lawrence also landed Bread Meat and Molasses

Tuesday Aug 13th

light breeze from S to S.W. with foggy weather finished landing provisions and sent Bent another Fore top rail and Fore shill

Wednesday Aug 14th

moderate breeze from the N.W. at 3 a.m. left Marble Island in company with the A. I. Ross and the Abbott Lawrence Steered about N.W.
