moderate breeze from the S.W. with clear weather Steady to the S. Saw Cape Mendocino Cape Fullerton two Sails in Site

Friday Aug 16th

Strong breeze from the S.W. Brig by the wind Short Sail Head and three vessels in Site

Saturday Aug 17th

light air from the S.W. to S.E. Saw the Abbott Lawrence chasing a whale carried Gutter on board Bark vice Capt Spicer Capt of the Schooner L. P. Ginnons came on board fore tattered the new London Fleet two Chomans and the above Bark left to day fore Cumberland Inlet 8 vessels in Site and Whale Point

Sunday Aug 18th

light air from the S.W. Saw on Bowhead from the Brig heard two Boats did not see the Whale again two Brigs and one schooner in Site the Isabella is off Whale point the above schooner's Story

Monday Aug 19th

moderate breeze from the S.W. Brig by the wind on different tracks Saw Black skin did not make it out 4 vessels in Site Ginnons the schooner Cotton Capt Berry and the Abbie Bradford had just finished Bailing sea Ball Whale making her 2500 Ball total

Friday Aug 23rd

Strong breeze from S to S.W. with rain Brig by the wind on different tracks Saw the Land the W. Shore heard a Fog Horn

Saturday Aug 24th

fresh gale from the S.W. with rain Brig by the wind on different tracks Saw one Sail at 2 P.M. Cape Fullerton Baring 8 1/2 miles distant Saw a Bowhead turned to starboard

Sunday Aug 25th

Strong breeze from the S.W. Brig by the wind on different tracks Abbott Lawrence in Site

Monday Aug 26th

moderate breeze from the S.W. Brig by the wind on different tracks Abbott Lawrence in Site Brig S. of Cape Fullerton 40 miles at 2 P.M.
