Tuesday Aug 27th

moderate breeze from N to S.W. Stearing to the N. Cape Palliser having
listened 15 miles saw the Abbott Lawrence
fasten to a whale

Wednesday Aug 28th

moderate breeze from S.W.
to S. by S. saw down Brig off below Bluff
saw the Abbie Bradford

Thursday Aug 29th

light breeze from the S.E. to
S.E. with rain saw the Abbie Bradford

Friday Aug 30th

fresh breeze from the S.E. to S.W.
with rainy weather Brig by the wind on different
tacks and steering S.S.W. at 1 P.M. supposed
the vessel to be to the S. of Cape Palliser

Saturday Aug 31st

moderate breeze from the
N.W. Stearing different courses to the S and W in
company with the Abbie Bradford

Sunday Sept 1st

moderate breeze from N.W. to S.E.
Stearing to the N.W. in company with the Abbott
Lawrence and Abbie Bradford saw the
Lapponer Co then at sundown Brig
off Whale point

Monday Sept 2nd

fresh breeze from the S.E. with
rain Brig by the wind on different tacks under short
sail saw one sail

Tuesday Sept 3rd

fresh breeze from the S.E.
Brig by the wind and Stearing different courses
took on board part of the S.S. Ross crew
that was wrecked on the 24 of August 10 miles
N of Cape Pender

Wednesday Sept 4th

light airs from N.W. to S.W.
with calm weather Brig off and on Pender Island
in company with the schooner Abbie Bradford and
the Abbott Lawrence the captains including
Capt Sinclair went on shore came off at 8 P.M.
we have seven of the crew of the S.S. Ross
four men and the first officer have agreed to go with
us the remainder of the crew lives one boatster
and one foremast hand as passengers

Thursday Sept 5th

moderate breeze from the
S.W. Stearing to the S.E. in company with the schooner
and Brig at 1 P.M. off Whale point
