Main Land

Friday oct 4th
fresh breeze from the
Eastward Boats on the main Land

Saturday oct 5th
moderate breeze from
the N.E. Boats on the main Land

Sunday oct 6th
moderate breeze from
the East Boats on the main Land

Monday oct 7th
moderate breeze from the
S.W. Boats on the main Land

Tuesday oct 8th
moderate breeze from
the S. with squally weather Boats
on the Main Land

Wednesday oct 9th
fresh breeze from the
S.W. with Snow Squalls Boats
returned from the Main Land
Bringing 700 Lbs of Deer meat
and a few Salmon

In Winter quarters 1878

Thursday oct 10th
first moderate breeze from
the S.W. two Boats started for the Main
Land carrying three Capt. latter part
fresh breeze let go the Second Anchor

Friday oct 11th
blowing a gale from the S.E.
with rain and Snow two Anchors down the
Capt on the Main Land

Saturday oct 12th
fresh breeze from the N.W.
with Snow Squalls here up and let go the
Second Anchor

Sunday oct 13th
moderate breeze from the N.
with pleasant weather both Anchors down

Monday oct 14th
light breeze from the N.E. with
pleasant weather two Anchors down

Tuesday oct 15th
moderate breeze from the N. with
pleasant weather

Wednesday oct 16th
moderate breeze from the Westward

Thursday oct 17th
moderate breeze from the
S.W. with Snow one Boat came from the
Main Land Bringing Capt. Fisher Capt
Morse and two Lbs of Deer Meat Capt
Savin and Capt Sinclair on the Main
Land
