Thermometer 35 below

Wednesday Feb 12th ^{light breeze from the S}
with pleasant weather Thermometer 25 below
gave a new arrival three natives. George
Murphy and Jacent Shanuell had a
little squabble a few minutes after the squabble
while Jacent Shanuell was sitting by the stove
the above George Murphy came up behind
him and struck him a severe blow across
the eye with a piece of white oak which knocked
him off the pair that he was sitting on Jacent
has got a very bad looking eye put Murphy in
irons at 1 o'clock took the irons off
