Thermometer 16 below

Monday, March 31st Fresh breeze from the N.E. Thermometer
16 below employed cutting out. Buckler and Thawing
Snow off Decks the Snow broke off our Bunkings

Tuesday, April 1st Strong breeze from the
S. Thermometer 15 below the Isabella
Bounced out of the ice too strong

Wednesday, April 2nd Fresh breeze from the S.
Thermometer 15 below employed sliding basket
to the Brigg

Thursday, April 3rd Light airs from the S.
Thermometer 16 above employed leaving ice digging
trenches

Saturday, April 5th commences with light airs
from the S. ends with a gale from the S. employed

Monday, April 7th moderate breeze from the S.
Thermometer 10 above employed cutting trenches

Tuesday, April 8th Light breeze from the S.
Thermometer 16 below Finished cutting trenches

Wednesday, April 9th Strong breeze from the S.E.
Thermometer 15 above employed coasting ice

Thursday, April 10th this day blowing a gale from
the S.E. Thermometer 16 above
