Boiled out and Stowed down 50 bbls of fresh
Water Sent new fore top gallant Sail sent up
crossed valves Brought us about 100 bbls of
Dear meat Thermometer 32 above

Thursday April 17th

Light breeze from the W
Finished boiling fresh Water about 100 bbls
repaired the fore top gallant main top sail & fixed
the old fore sail up Thermometer 25 above
