Friday, April 25th Strong breeze from the N.W. our Hunters Brought us about 100 lbs of meat

Saturday, April 26th Strong breeze from the N.W. with clear cool weather

Sunday, April 27th Fresh breeze from the N.W. Thermometer 6 above

Monday, April 28th Fresh breeze from the S.E.

Tuesday, April 29th light breeze from the S. put a new Sargard in the main digging Shovelled the ~~ice~~ ^{ice} of the Trenches

Wednesday April 30th moderate breeze from the S.

Thursday May 1st light breeze from the S. with pleasant weather employed Painting Boats and Ship Drying Sails repairing rigging

Friday May 2nd light breeze from the S.E. with foggy weather employed Scraping mast setting rigging some of our Hunters Arrived from the main Land Bringing our Second Mate and two Deer

Saturday May 3rd moderate breeze from the S. with foggy weather cleaned out our Trenches

Sunday May 4th light breeze from the N.W. with pleasant weather

Monday May 5th light air from the W. Painted the W.B. foot the 2. quarter Boards the cranes painted or companion line covers repairing rigging

Tuesday May 6th light air from the N. employed painting repairing rigging Sails

Wednesday May 7th Strong breeze from the N.W. employed cutting Trenches

Thursday May 8th Strong breeze from the N.W. employed Shaving the Shore Ice out to give the ice a chance to go out the Main Pack of ice is out of Site from this Harbor

Friday May 9th light breeze from the S.W. at 3 a.m. commenced Trenching and Sailing Working Watch and Watch the 24 hours

Saturday May 10th at 2 a.m. light breeze from S. to Sailing wind S. at 1 a.m. commenced Sailing again wind N at 1 a.m. backed off Sailing ice
