Friday June 6th

moderate breeze from the N.W.
Depot Island in sight at 6 a.m.
+ Good fore Whales the S.B. caught one
got the Boat a little stove by the whale
running among the ice finished cutting
and commenced Boiling

Saturday June 7th

moderate breeze from the N.W.
S.W. looked down the Bay in the morning
started them again towards noon two Sails in
the Abbie Bradford Boiling

Sunday June 8th

moderate breeze from the N.W.
at 1 P.M. finished Boiling spoke the Abbie
Bradford Capt Fisher had taken two good
Whales since leaving Marble Head & winter
quarters

Monday June 9th

Strong breeze from the E. vessel
steering down along the Sound to the Sand W
+ Abbie Bradford and Cotten in sight in the
forenoon at 5 a.m. off Bakers Foreland
Abbot Lawrence in sight and her Boats are
down

Tuesday June 10th

Strong breeze from the S.E.
with snow Abbot Lawrence in sight 4 m
off Bakers Foreland P.M. working towards
Depot Island

Capt L. Davis Master Cruising in Hudson Bay

Wednesday June 11th

light air from the S. with calm
weather 3 a.m. Saw two Whales lowered
+ three Boats did not see them out of the Boatswain
of Depot Island two Sails and plenty of ice
off shore

Thursday June 12th

moderate breeze from the N.W.
to S.E. with snow Squalls cruising off Depot Island
+ three Sails in sight saw the other chasing Whales

Friday June 13th

light breeze from the N.E. with snow
Squalls Capt went on shore and came off again from
+ Depot Island Capt Sinclair and Boat crew of natives
Bringing Musk & Skins saw the other chasing Whales

Saturday June 14th

moderate breeze from the S.E.
at 7 a.m. off Bakers Foreland three Sails in
+ sight Capt Fisher saw a Whale at 2 p.m. heading
to the N. towards Depot Island in company with three
other vessels

Sunday June 15th

moderate breeze from the S.E. with
+ hazy weather saw the Abbie Bradfords Boats boat
a Whale saw the Abbot Lawrence Whaling spoke
the A.D. had caught one Whale this Spring three
Sails and Bakers Foreland in sight
