courses up and down the Sound. Saw several
Native's Totipies on the S.W. end of Southampton
the A. Bradfords Boat landed there is no
Ice in site off shore

Sunday June 29th

moderate breeze from the N.W.
at 5 a.m. saw a Bowhead Whale lured
at 7 a.m. chased till 11 a.m. no chance
P.M. Edie Bradford and one the A. Lawrence
Whaling

Monday June 30th

fresh breeze from the S.E. vessel
cruising off the W. coast of Hudsons Bay in company
with the A. Bradford and the A. Lawrence the Bradford
caught a Whale saw him cutting for Anchor
saw a Whale last night that the A. Lawrence
was chasing

Tuesday July 1st

Strong breeze from the N.E. at 4 a.m.
A.M. lured for a Whale did not see him
out of the Boats at 6 a.m. came on board lured again
at 8 a.m. did not see the Whale after the
Boats lured saw the Lawrence's Boats down
the A. Bradford Boiling at 2 a.m.
the 3 vessels anchored in 10 fathoms
of water

Water Cruising in Hudsons Bay 1879

Wednesday July 2nd

fresh breeze from the N.E.
Brig Anchored in 10 fathoms of water on the
S. side of Hudsons Bay the A. Bradford lured
for a Bowhead succeeded the three captains went
on shore hunting Bent new Main topmast they said
the captains came on board at 10 p.m. bringing 3 Deer
one a piece

Thursday July 3rd

moderate breeze from S. to W.
Brig Anchored the 2nd and 3rd officers and
several of the men went on shore they all came off
at 7 p.m. but the Cook and officer

Friday July 4th

fresh breeze from the S.W.
Brig Anchored Capt Fisher and Capt Samin went
on shore Deer Hunting Brought off 11 Eggs
Mr. Foster came on board about 8 a.m.

Saturday July 5th

moderate breeze from the N.W.
at 2 a.m. took our Duchen and Shade Sail
cruising off the S.W. end of South Hampton
the A. Bradford and A. Lawrence in site

Sunday July 6th

commenced with light breeze from
the N.W. with pleasant weather. Brig by the wind ran
different tacks off the W. coast of the Bay. two sails
in site latter strong breeze from the S. with fog and
rain
