Remarks on Lord Bagg Isabella

Sunday July 27th

moderate breeze from S to round
to the Westward to S again with rain and fog.
Steering different courses to the Southward and Eastward
Soundings from 22 to 23. Bottoms of Water Saw
two Soils. Anchored about 11. P. M. 17. Bottoms
about half way from Maurice sent to the S. W. end of Southampton.
Monday July 28th

Monday July 28th moderate breeze from the S.W. &
cleared off about 10 A.M. took our Anchor Breeze by
the wind on different tacks came in Foggy about 3
P.M.

Tuesday, July 29th

light breeze from the S. & W.
with Fog about half of the day, looking round
where Whales have been seen at 6 P. Steering
N. W. Land 6 miles off Bering S. E. the S. W.
end of Southampton

Wednesday July 20th

light breeze from the S.W.
Saw the 1st Shore of Cape Kendall Sunday
from 15 to 30 Pelicans passed the above Cape
about 2 P.M. having S.E. rainy weather

Thursday, July 31st

moderate breeze from the S. with
clear weather most of the day, vessel off Whale
paint. Damned the Schooner Eothen and took
Mr Randol's Boat that he lent Capt Perry
Leashed her over the vessels Stern had several
Natives on Board and among them Capt Marco
of Launch Fort Church Hill we supposed he must
have Stowed her brought some Beer Meet

moderate breeze from the S.
with clear weather. Solow, Pitt in Sit. Hammel, the
A. Bradford and A. Lawrence Poyed off our
two Native Boys and sent them on Shore bound
to Noble Island in company with the A. B. vessels
to Kite for Home

Thursday Aug 2^d

commences with strong
breeze from the S.W. by the wind and indifferent looks
later part light airs with the calm weather here
Sails A. B. and C. So. Breeze off Cape Hullison

Sunday Aug. 3rd

fresh breeze from the S. with foggy weather steering to the S.W. at 1 P.M. saw the A. Lawrence keep off fore Depot Island the A. Bradford and us keep going fore Marble Island lured two at 5 P.M. suppose the Island to be about 12 miles off Gammed the A. Bradford Capt Linder is stopping on Board the Abbie

Monday Aug 4th

Monday May 11th Stevedores from the ship with the Fox
Saw Marble Island Anchored at 5.00 & some employed
Getting off Water Provisions mostly Casks and so forth
The D. Bradford is getting Water & L. Lowman & Liver
about 10 P.M.

Tuesday Aug 5th

moderate breeze from N to S W
pleasant weather. Finished getting water and
wood Bent Van foremast. Hoysail rather second
hand new fore no
