

Remarks on board Brig Isabella

Wednesday Aug 6th

light breeze from S.W. to S.S.W. with fog 6 or 8 M. took our anchor and towed out of Marble Island Harbor S. Bradford and the A. Lawrence all of which are bound for New Bedford Steering E.

Thursday Aug 7th

light breeze from the S.S.W. with clear weather Steering E. true S. B. and by S. in S. E. Astern at 1 P.M. the S.W. end of Southampton in S. E. bearing N. E. distance 12 miles

Lat 62° 30' N Long 82° 28' W.

Friday Aug 8th

light breeze from the S. Steering S. by there is 4 points variation Westerly there the straits by our compass gammed the S. B. and A. S. 6 P.M. Cape Pembroke bearing S. 4 miles off Dead calm

Saturday Aug 9th

light air from the S. and N.W. Steering S. by S. 5 points variation at 2 P.M. Cape Pembroke out of S. E. A. B. and A. S. in S. E. Saw Chooer both in Astern

Sunday Aug 10th

light air from S. E. W. during the evening 6 points variation morning 4 points Nottingham the Digges and the Coast of Labrador three Sails in S. E. Steering for the Eastward

Monday Aug 11th

fresh breeze from the N.W. in the evening weather Steering to the Eastward 5 points variation Charles Island and the Coast of Labrador two Sails have been there

Long 73° 44' W

Tuesday Aug 12th

fresh breeze from the N.W. with clear weather Steering S. by S. Saw Ice Berge and the W. Shore of the Straits A. Bradford in S. E. Corried away the main Boom jibbing Davit Fire S. B.

Lat 61° 44' N Long 68° 48' W

Wednesday Aug 13th

light breeze from the N. with fog Steering from S. to S. S. W. we supposed ourselves to be to the Eastward of Buttons Islands Saw the A. Bradford at 4 P.M.

Thursday Aug 14th

light breeze from the N.W. with rain and clear weather Saw the Coast and several Ice Berge Brig Steering S. by N.

Lat 61° 11' N Long 62° 53' W

Friday Aug 15th

first moderate breeze from the N. S. latter strong breeze from the N. with thick weather Steering S. by W. by Compass at 10 P.M. Broke the Main Boom in two halving it in to Luff too did not luff to keep her agoing all night
