

Remarks on board Brig, Isabella G. Gannin

Saturday Aug 16th

Strong and fresh breeze from N. to N.W. with thick weather. Steering until 2:00 P.M. hiked for the wind heading N.E. under two Sloop sails and reef mainsail kept off at 11 P.M. Offered S.

Sunday Aug 17th

moderate breeze from the N.W. Steering S. and S by W and S by W. 2. W. Saw one Ice Berg.

Lat 53. 41. Long 58. 39

Monday Aug 18th

fresh breeze from the N.W. with cloudy weather. Steering from S by W to S by W. at 11 A.M. saw a vessel heading to the S.W.

Lat 52. 08. Long 57. 45. W

Tuesday Aug 19th

first part fresh breeze from the N.W. Steering S.W. 3/4 S. latter calm weather employed washing the vessel

Lat 48. 38. Long 56. 40

Wednesday Aug 20th

first calm and light air from the S. latter fresh breeze from the N.E. with thick rainy weather. Steering N.W. S.W. and S.W. by W. finished washing the vessel. Saw a bark heading to the Eastward belonging to Harver.

Lat 48. 26. Long 56. 22. W

Thursday Aug 21st

moderate breeze from N. by E. Steering from S.W. by S. to W. Saw two Sails. Sound shot 40 fathoms marks our Chronometer 10 miles to the N. Lat 46. 04. Long 53. 46. W.

Friday Aug 22nd

moderate breeze from the N. by E. Steering by the wind on different tacks. Saw two Sails and one Steamer. all hands Washed and Bundled all off the Bone.

Lat 45. 45. N Long 54. 53. W

Saturday Aug 23rd

commenced with calm weather middle moderate breeze from the S. Steering W by S. latter moderate breeze from the west vessel by the wind. Saw two Sails but heading the same as us.

Lat 45. 00. N Long 53. 46. W

Sunday Aug 24th

fresh breeze from the S.W. with fog and rain. Lightning and Thunder. Saw two Sails. Spoke the A. B. Bradford haven't seen her before since being Button Islands. Bradford's Lat 56. 33. W. Repaired the Sloop's Sloop.

Lat 45. 25. N Long 54. 32. W

Monday Aug 25th

first and middle moderate breeze from the N.W. with calm weather latter light air from the North fog. Damned the A. Bradford.

Lat 45. 10. N Long 53. 41. W

Tuesday Aug 26th

commenced with light breeze from the S. Steering S.W. by W. S.W. 1/2 W. Saw 10 Sails and the A. Bradford latter fresh breeze from the N.W. with fog and rain.

Wednesday Aug 27th

fresh breeze from the S.W. with cloudy weather. Steering N.W. S.W. and W. Saw two Sails at 3 P.M. the vessel reinvented about 6. Small Sperm Whales that were sailing to windward.
