

Ship Israel Bound to the West

Tuesday Sept 1st 1846
Commenced with light breezes from the W course & by 11 AM all sail & all hands employed taking up the mast by the night rigging & the middle and latter light breezes were making good at 7 AM saw a school of black fish in the weather quarter gave to windward and out here the ends

Wednesday Sept 2 Began with light breeze and squally from the W & W by S barbed tacks on board All hands employed on ships duty middle light breeze and squally hard main royal and 3rd sail later went light breezes and calm All sail course & fair breezes to ends

Longitude by Cn 46° 14' W

Thursday Sept 3 Commenced with light breezes from W by N course & by 11 AM all sail All hands employed on ships duty here cloudy middle squally with heavy rain fair wind latter went strong breeze from W Latitude by obs 38° 58' N Longitude by Cn 44° 01' 1/2 W

Friday Sept 4 Began with strong breezes from the W by S & cloudy here rain By the wind barbed tacks on board All sail & at 12 PM the fly jib got put in but it in got run one fore stretch with her old sample rope Various middle and latter strong breezes and cloudy shading & S & barbed tacks on board All sail so ends

Saturday Sept 5 Commenced with strong breezes and cloudy weather from the W & barbed tacks on board All sail All hands employed Various sent out new fly jib good middle pleasant breezes latter light breezes and pleasant

Longitude by Cn 39° 32' W

Sunday Sept 6 Began with light breezes from the W & barbed tacks on board pleasant and sun cloudy All hands employed Various middle and latter light breezes and calm latter fair wind course & by 11 AM the ends

Longitude by Cn 38° 33' W

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Monday Sept 7 1846
Began with light breezes from the W course & by 11 AM all sail and pleasant weather on latter on deck middle and latter strong breezes and cloudy on latter course 18 1/2 S to ends

Latitude by obs 38° 55' N
Longitude by Cn 35° 55' W

Tuesday Sept 8
Commenced with strong breezes from the W course & by 11 AM all sail & by 1 PM half S cloudy weather all hands employed variously middle and latter pleasant breezes from the W & W by S course & by 5 1/2 PM at 2 PM speak the yawstar of New Bedford

Latitude by obs 39° 15' N
Longitude by Cn 33° 15' W

Wednesday Sept 9
Began with pleasant breezes from the W and All sail course & All hands employed variously At 8 PM course & 3/4 S middle light breezes and pleasant latter much the same at 9 AM saw Flores Baring & by 5 about 30 miles off course & S & All sail middle part haul for and upon 1/2 S sail at day light let & gain the yawstar in company So ends

Latitude by obs 39° 21' N
Longitude by Cn 31° 24' W

Thursday Sept 10 Commenced with light breezes and pleasant weather from the S by the wind barbed tacks on board All sail all hands employed variously The yawstar in company At sunset hauled about two miles of the East point bearing & W & ship heading & by 8 1/2 middle fresh breezes and squally latter part strong breezes Hauling of and on in company with the yawstar at 7 PM The Captain went on shore on boats came to ends the Capt on shore after recruits

Friday Sept 11 Commenced with fresh breezes from the S by W All hands employed The Capt on shore ship laying of and on At 3 PM at shore boat came & by side with potatoes Chickens &c Captain came on board At 5 PM At 6 PM 2 reefs in top sail strong breezes and squally At 11 AM main sail blowing On At 5 PM At 7 PM heading in shore At 9 AM of shore heading & S & barbed tacks on board At 10 AM haul for and upon in sails blowing & gale
