Saturday 26th

Breeze trades and cloudy steering in for Black
Beach at 2 PM sent a boat on board a Brig laying
at anchor off B Beach report the death of Capt
Mason on board of Adams no further particulars
at 3 Boat returned run down to Office bay at 4 Boat
went along side ship N 1/2 E 6 miles out 50 miles
at 6 Boat returned with ship to the N 4 West middle latter
part heavy at 7 saw sperm whale rainy weather thick on fish
