Friday July 31st 1845

Moderate winds and fair weather, standing to the N.W. more B. fish in sight middle and latter part the same steering S.W.

Saturday 31st Lat 3.33 Long 97.81

Fresh winds and fair weather, course S.W. saw Finbacks middle part the same latter part steering N.W. put down the No. 1 topsail and repaired it sound Lat 5.03 Long 98.46

Sunday 31st

Strong trades and clear weather, running N.W. saw Finbacks middle part by the wind latter part steering off Lat 4.18 Long 100.20

Monday 31st

B. fish trades and fair weather, angling off to the N. saw Finbacks Lat 4.41

Tuesday 31st

Strong winds and cloudy weather, one squall of rain middle part heading to the Eastward, latter running to the Westward

Wednesday 25th Lat 4.40 Long 101.44

Strong winds and fair weather, running S.W. at sundown shifted to within N.W. to the mast at daylight backed forward to the N. saw Finbacks Lat 4.40 Long 103.02

Thursday 26th

Winds strong weather fair steering S.W. by N. middle part aback latter steering N.W.

Friday 27th Lat 4.21 Long 103.57

Strong winds steering S.W. at sundown saw a pair in the E. det middle and latter part some squally Lat 4.32 Long 104.32

Saturday 28th

Strong winds running N. middle and latter heading N.E. Lat 3.16 Long 104.10

Sunday 29th All these 24 hours heading to the N.E. by

the winds were more moderate saw Finbacks B. fish kippers Lat 2.15 Long 103.40 Lat 2.15

All these 24 hours brisk winds and fair weather standing to the N.E. by the wind saw Porpoises

Tuesday July 1st 1845 Lat 1.08 S

Moderate winds and fine weather, standing by the wind to the N.E. latter part steering N. saw Blackfish Lat 18 miles S

Wednesday 2nd

Light winds and fine weather, steering N. to the middle part lying aback latter part running S.W. saw Lat 11 miles S Long 103.8

Thursday 3rd

Moderate winds and fine weather, steering S.W. middle part lying aback latter part steering

Friday 4th N.W. saw Porpoises Lat 00 Long 105.09

B. fish winds and fair weather, steering S.W. by N. middle part lying aback at daylight steering S.W. N.W. saw Blackfish Lat 39 miles S Long 105.09

Saturday 5th

B. fish winds and fair weather, steering S.W. by N. middle part S.W. latter part the same saw Lat 11.49 S Long 106.09

Sunday 6th

B. fish winds and fine weather, standing to the S.W. middle and latter part wind light saw Porpoises Finbacks Lat 3.24

Monday 7th

All these 24 hours light winds and fine weather heading South saw Porpoises

Tuesday 8th Lat 4.53 Long 107.02

Moderate winds and fine weather, still heading to the S. saw a pair in the S.W. at 7 AM spoke the Corinthian Capt. Munkley 20 miles out 10.50 S.W. middle part lying aback latter part steering S.W. by N. Lat 5.17 Long 108.12

Wednesday 9th light winds and fine weather, steering

N.W. middle part aback latter part steering N.W. saw Lat 4.42 Long 108.48
