

Ship James Allen off shore

Friday August 23<sup>rd</sup> 1845

Strong winds and fine weather all this day

Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> Lat 5.33 Long 111.36

All this day off shore weather and now what sounds Lat 4.08 Long 111.10

Sunday 24<sup>th</sup>

Moderate strong weather fair sounds

Monday 25<sup>th</sup> Lat 4.45 Long 111.28

Begins with fresh winds fair weather middle and latter part more moderate

Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> Lat 5.20 No Altitude

Moderate winds and fair weather all the 24 hours sounds again Lat 4.38 Long 111.30

Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup>

Fair weather, at sundown shortened sail and luffed to the wind with the No Top sail to the mast at daylight stowed off A.M.

Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> Lat 4.45 Long 112.30

Full smooth at 3 P.M. spoke Ship Eagle Capt Woods A.M. out 5.50 8.00 P.M. Cal middle part lying aback at daylight kept off P.M.

Friday 29<sup>th</sup> Lat 5.20 Long 113.49

Fine weather, at sundown luffed to within the No Top sail to the mast heading N.E. latter part steering off sounds Lat 4.10 Long 114.37 by Lat 113.44

Saturday 30<sup>th</sup>

Full good weather, anchoring off saw a Boby middle part fine at daylight saw a whale going to windward down boats pond in chase Lat 4.46 Long 115.06

Sunday 31<sup>st</sup>

Strong trades and fair Bots still in chase at 5 P.M. struck and killed one at dark took along side lay heading to the N.E. at daylight hooked on one sail in sight sounds Lat 4.54 Long 115.48

Monday Sept 1<sup>st</sup> 1845

Begins with fine weather at 3 P.M. finished cutting and stowed to the South at daylight. Commenced boiling sounds fair weather

Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> Lat 5.03 Long 115.38

Fair weather employed boiling sounds

Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> Lat 5.16 Long 115.42

Fine weather, still boiling at 10 A.M. finished boiling and washed off sounds

Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> Lat 4.46 Long 115.07

All this day fair weather, standing to the N.E. sounds Lat 4.33 Long 114.57

Friday 5<sup>th</sup>

Full good weather, at sundown hoisted the No Top sail to the mast at daylight stowed off A.M. sounds Lat 5.37 Long 115.32 by Lat 115.06

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup>

Moderate weather, steering off for Long 116 made and latter part strong winds sounds the day

Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> Lat 5.37 Long 116.14 by Lat 116.18

Strong winds to at 2 P.M. saw a sail middle & latter part weather much the same

Monday 8<sup>th</sup> Lat 5.02 Long 115.48 by Lat 115.40

All this day fresh winds and fair weather at daylight began to stow off Lat 4.18 Long 115.40

Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup>

All this day off shore weather, no whales

Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> Lat 4.50 Long 115.23 by Lat 115.40

Strong winds weather fair sounds

Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> Lat 5.45 Long 114.50

Tuesday fine weather and moderate wind

Friday 12 working to the Eastward Lat 5.24 Long 113.56

Moderate weather, much the same as day previous sounds Lat 4.56 Long 113.22

Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> All the 24 hours fine weather, sounds

Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> Lat 5.18 Long 113.11

Begins moderate middle and latter part squally sounds this 24 hours

Lat 5.42 Long 112.61
