

James Allen bound in Phoenix
Thursday Oct 9th 1845

Breeze winds and overcast weather heading
by the middle of N.E. middle part light winds
later part fresh winds one squall of rain

Friday 10th Lat 13 miles N Long 100.22

Breeze trades and fair weather heading E by N
middle part moderate later fresh winds fair
weather, sounds Lat 21 m N Long 99.12

Saturday 11th

Strong trades and fair weather heading E at 11 past
5 PM saw whales going quick to windward to
late to home middle and later part strong
winds and fair weather, sounds

Sunday 12th Lat 3 m S Long 97.46

Fresh winds and fair weather saw 2 porpoises
middle and later part moderate and cloudy

Monday 13th Lat 3 m N Long 96.56

All these 24 hours strong winds and overcast
weather heading E by S sounds

Tuesday 14th Lat 28 m N Long

First part fair middle and later part
cloudy heading E by S saw Porpoises

Wednesday 15th Lat 5 1/2 m N Long 92.36

Strong winds and fair weather heading
E by S middle part light winds later part the
same saw Menmans Island bearing N dist
35 miles Lat 50 m N Long 91.39

Thursday 16th

Light winds fair weather at sundown
Menmans bore N by E dist 20 miles and
N.W. made bore E by S dist 40 miles middle
and later part fresh winds at daylight
Abington bearing E dist 15 miles sounds

Friday 17th Lat 48 m N Long 90.24

Strong winds and fair weather at sundown
Abington bearing N by S dist 40 miles
middle and later part strong winds and
cloudy Lat 35 m N

Ship James Allen bound in Phoenix
Saturday Oct 18th 1845

Strong winds and cloudy heading E by N middle
part winds more moderate later strong winds
and cloudy sounds Lat 7 m N

Sunday 19th

Breeze winds and overcast weather heading
E by N at dusk saw whales going E to later to home
again at 10 AM went ship to the N.W. sounds
Lat 9 m S Long 86.29

Monday 20

Moderate winds and heavy at meridian saw
two whales at 1 PM hauled struck kille do on
at sundown took to the ship got the Row Boat
stove to lay by through the night at daylight
hooked on sounds cutting No Obs

Tuesday 21st

Finished cutting at 3 finished and made sail to the
N.W. middle and later part fine weather
sounds the day Lat 3 m N Long 86.30

Wednesday 22nd

All these 24 hours boiling weather fine sounds

Thursday 23rd Lat 10 m N Long 86.30

Full fine weather, sun plays to boiling at meridian
finished and washed off Lat 28 m S Long 85.55

Friday 24th

Fair weather all the 24 hours sounds again

Saturday 25th Lat 1.05 Long 86.13

Fine weather at 1 PM saw whales down Boat
struck kille do at sundown took along side
by heading to the E at daylight hooked on at
9 AM finished cutting and made sail to the
N.W. No Obs supposed 40 m N Long 87.00

Sunday 26th

Begins fine middle and later part thick
weather, at daylight commenced boiling

Monday 27th No Obs 50 m S Long 86.30

Thick weather at meridian saw a dead whale which
proved to be our unlanded whale getting the other took
to the ship at 4 finished cutting &c
Lat 11 m S Long 86.15
