

Ship's Tamed *Albino* off Shore

Friday Feb 20th 1846

All these 24 hours fresh trades and fair weather, sounds the day Lat 4.27 Long 104.03

Saturday 21st

(Fair clear off shore weather, and no whale sounds the 24 hours Lat 4.37 Long 105.05)

Sunday 22nd

Still strong trades at sunset spoke ship *Albino* Baskin, Capt Brayton 5 mo out 150 ym. Wh 100 whale sounds one ship in sight

Monday 23rd

Lat 5.15 Long 105.39

All these 24 hours fresh trades angling off to the west sounds Lat 4.37 Long 107.12

Tuesday 24th

Strong trades and fair weather, in want of whales sounds working off Lat 4.49 Long 108.20

Wednesday 25th

Weather, fair winds strong no whales to day sounds the 24 hours Lat 5.35 Long 109.14

Thursday 26th

Begins with strong winds middle and later part moderate angling off

Friday 27th

Lat 5.03 Long 110.20

Fair weather at 3 PM saw whales at 4 lowered truck and killed one at 8 took to the ship got third and it B rats store by heading to the N.E. at daylight hooked on sounds cutting Lat 5.10 Long 112.36

Saturday 28th

B Fair weather at 1 PM finished cutting and made sail to the *Albino* at sunset by an to boat the day ends fair Lat 5.43 Long 110.13

Sunday 29 March 1st 1846

X Begins fresh trades middle and latter part moderate sounds B along Lat 5.15 Long 109.15

S. James *Albino* off Shore

Monday March 2nd 1846

X Fair weather at sunset hauled the m. 20 fms at daylight hauled forward at noon night finished looking middle and latter part fine and light winds sounds Lat 4.25 Long 109.27 by 109.17

Tuesday 3rd

X Fair weather, light winds middle and latter part the same at 10 AM saw whales at 11 lowered the boats sounds in chase

Wednesday 4th

Lat 4.28 Long 110.36

X Fair weather at 3 struck at 4 took along side at 5 commenced cutting at sunset head off stacked up for the night at daylight by an again at 7.30 m finished and made sail to the *Albino* sounds

Thursday 5th

Lat 4.28 Long 111.11

X Fresh winds and fair weather at 1 PM began to B. middle part squally latter part fine sounds Lat 5.08 Long 111.14 by Lunar 111.15

Friday 6th

X All these 24 hours fair weather at 8 AM finished looking sounds Lat 5.05 Long 111.05

Saturday 7th

X Fair weather all the 24 hours and so they the day ends Lat 5.35 Long 111.32

Sunday 8th

X Fair weather, and fresh winds all day sounds Lat 4.50 Long 110.45

Monday 9th

Still fair steering many courses middle and latter employed stowing oil in the *Albino*

Tuesday 10th

Lat 4.30 Long 110.13

Fair weather all day stowing oil sounds

Wednesday 11th

Lat 4.25 Long 111.35

All this day fresh winds and fair weather sounds Lat 5.05 Long 111.30

Thursday 12th

Off shore weather, and no whale sounds Lat 4.57 Long 111.58

Friday 13th

Fresh trades middle and latter and latter part squally sounds Lat 4.40 Long 112.30
