

Ship James A. Allen off Thore

Saturday, March 14th 1846

Still squally at sunset downer up to the topsails
middle and latter part squally so ends

Sunday 15th Lat 50.9 Long 115.00

Squally and rainy all the 24 hours sounds

Monday 16th Lat 45.6 Long 112.58

Fair weather at sunset. Doubly reefed the
topsails middle and latter part fair

Tuesday 17th Lat 5.00 Long 112.30

Good weather at sunset backed the
topsail to the mast heading to the N.E.

middle and latter part squally so ends

Wednesday 18th Lat 35.6 Long 113.13

Began squally middle and latter part
fair with strong winds steering S.W. sounds

Thursday 19th Lat 4.31 Long 114.51

Fair weather at sunset shortened sail
and wore ships to the E. N.E. middle and
latter part squally and rainy sounds

Friday 20th Lat 5.18 Long 116.00

Squally and rainy all the 24 hours
still without whales Lat 4.50 Long 116.10

Saturday 21st

All these 24 hours rainy at 10 A.M.
close reefed the topsails under jibs

Sunday 22nd North sounds rainy Lat 5.25 Long 116.10

Full rain at 2 P.M. cleared off wind and
middle and latter part fair sounds

Monday 23rd Lat 5.15 Long 115.40

At sunset hauled the main topsail
to the mast heading N.E. at daylight
kept off west sounds Lat 4.04 Long 115.35

Tuesday 24th

Fair weather at sunset shortened sail and
luffed to the wind with the S. topsail to the
mast heading S at daylight steered N.W.
sounds the 24 hours

Lat 4.52 Long 117.18

James Allen towards the Line

Wednesday, March 25th 1846

Broke trades and fine weather angling off
at sunset shortened sail and luffed to the wind
heading S latter part steering N.W. plenty
of rain sounds No Obs

Thursday 26th

Fresh winds and fair weather angling
off middle part by the middle latter part
steering N.W. and N.E. Lat 4.54 Long 118.39

Friday 27th

Strong trades and fair weather middle
and latter part squally and rainy heading
N.W. and N.E. by N. Lat 3.23 Long 118.28

Saturday 28th

Strong winds and squally at 1 P.M. saw
whales to take to lower middle and
latter part fair saw Porpoises sounds

Sunday 29th Lat 2.53 Long 118.33

All this day moderate winds and fair
weather heading by the wind N.W. saw
Finbacks Lat 1.45 P Long 118.00

Monday 30th

Moderate winds and fair weather caught
a Porpoise and saw Finbacks middle and
latter part light winds sounds Lat 3.00 M Long 117.46

Tuesday 31st

All these 24 hours wind light latter part
running off sounds wind light Lat 00

Wednesday April 1st Long 118.44 Lat 00

All this day wind light weather fair saw
plenty of Porpoises & sent down the 7th flag
Lat 00 Long 118.52

Thursday 2nd

Full light air and fair weather sent up
the 7th flag & middle and latter part

Friday 3rd wind light some rain and 4th current

Lat 15 M N Long

Light air and rainy trying to get to the S. made
and latter part fair part Porpoises & Finbacks
sounds the day Lat 5 M Long 119.40
