Light winds and fair weather, working to the
I saw Porpoises middle and latter part equally
at 10 Am saw whales sounds running for them

Sunday 5th Lat 30 N Long 121 30

I Squally at midnight landed the Boats at 4
amuck and killed 2 at 7 took them to the ship
do made sail to the M at daylight hooked
at 8 finished and made sail to the M a plenty
of Blackfish in sight sounds rather fair, wind
light Lat 45 N Long 121 36

Monday 6

Fair weather at 4 Pm commenced boiling
middle and latter part fine weather
sounds boiling Lat 1 02 Long 122 02

Tuesday 7th

Still fine at 8 Pm finished boiling middle
and latter part fine weather, working off

Wednesday 8th Lat 29 N Long 122 30

Fair weather, at sunset left to within the
main topsail to the mast heading N E at
daylight made sail to the M at 10 Am saw
whales going quick to the L down boats struck
drew the Iron whale went off sounds boats still
in chase Lat 30 N Long 123 23

Thursday 9th

Fair weather, Boats in chase at 3 struck 3
whales lost on by the Iron drawing at 8 Pm
took to the ship and braced forward to the
M at daylight hooked on at 9 finished
and stood to the M sounds fine

Friday 10th Lat 45 N Long 123 50

x B Begins fair at 5 Pm began to frame middle
part rainy at daylight fair began to boil

Saturday 11th Lat 1 23 Long 124 30

Fair weather at 3 Pm saw whales down boats
x struck took the line and went off middle
and latter part fair sounds
Lat 1 00 Long 124 39

On this line
Sunday Apr 12th 1846

x Good weather at 3 Pm finished boiling & middle
and latter part fair at 10 Am saw whales landed
the Boats whales going to quick to the L sounds

Monday 13th Lat 37 N Long 124 48

Fair weather fresh winds fine & strong current
x setting to the West middle part equally latter part
fair sounds Lat 1 1 Long 125 05

Tuesday 14th

Brisk trades and fair weather, heading
x by the winds N E middle part some squally
latter part fair saw Embarked &c

Wednesday 15th Lat 15 N Long 124 52

Brisk trades and fair weather, employed
Painting the Stern middle and latter part
fair sounds the day Lat 27 N Long

Thursday 16th

Brisk trades and fair weather, employed
breaking out the After, Holes to fill the 3
middle and latter part fair at 6 Am saw
whales going to the L down boats struck
and 3 at midnight took them along side
sounds Lat 14 N Long 125 31

Friday 17th light winds and fair weather, at
3 Pm finished at 8 and stood to the M

latter part saw Porpoises and Blackfish
sounds Lat 1 15 Long 126 18

Saturday 18th

Brisk trades and fair weather, employed
boiling and stowing Oil in the After Holes
middle and latter part fair stowing Oil and
Boiling sounds Lat 10 N Long 125 33

Sunday 19th

Brisk trades and fair weather finished
stowing Oil &c at 5 Am finished boiling sounds
fair weather Lat 35 N Long 126 18
